Stewardship Calling

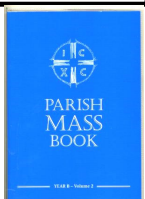
"Now the Lord has spoken who formed me as his servant from the womb..." Isaiah 49:5A

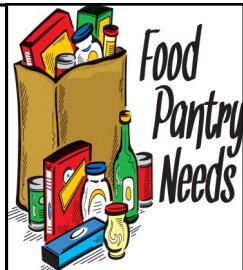
