**Etiquette in Church**

Over the past weeks, since Easter Sunday, I have been offering a reminder from the Altar concerning a specific

point of established Church Etiquette. Those of you with “long Catholic memories” will recall the adage: The priest should be the last person to enter the aisle to begin Mass and the first person to walk out to greet you in the lobby after Mass has ended.

That is what courteous behavior looks like in practice. It begins with having learned to respect the holiness of the place: a church whose altar was consecrated on the day of the Dedication of the Church back in 1969. Along with the structure, the tabernacle, baptistry, statues and the stained glass windows were blessed in order that they would inspire us and lift our prayers heavenward.

The joyful celebration of the Sunday Eucharist allows us to hear the Word of God proclaimed and to receive worthily the Body of Christ, with an open heart. After receiving Communion and returning to one’s pew, we are encouraged to kneel or sit, and enter into a moment of grateful prayer, as we now have the body of the Lord Jesus within us. Pause. Sing with the Music Minister or listen to the message of the Communion Hymn. Prepare for the Priest to pray the Post Communion Prayer, highlight a special announcement and dismiss those Eucharistic Ministers who will bring Communion to the sick and housebound. The Priest offers the final Blessing and together with the Deacon’s words exhorts us to “Go in Peace to love and serve the Lord”.

Wait for the ministers to walk to the rear of the Church during the Recessional Hymn to greet everyone. Church Etiquette dictates that except for an emergency reason, we should not be leaving the church after receiving our Communion and directly exiting towards the parking lot. Is there really such a rush to escape from the parking lot...to make it to the restaurant...to another event? If this behavior has become habitual, consider a decision to break the cycle. Your good example can have a positive effect upon others seated around you, it really does.

Remember to “fast” one hour from food before receiving Holy Communion. Water never breaks the fast. Easter Duty: once a year confession of any mortal sins and reception of Holy Communion from the first Sunday of Lent, February 18, 2018 through Trinity Sunday, May 27, 2018.

Our First Communion Masses have begun as of Sunday, April 22 at 10:00AM. They will continue on these dates and times: Sunday, May 6 at 10:00AM; Saturday, May 19 at 5:00PM and Sunday, May 20 at 8:00AM.

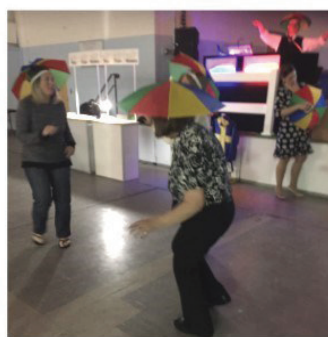
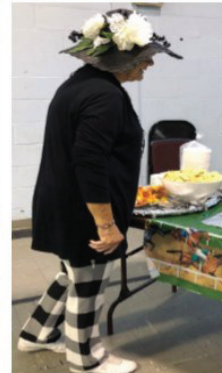
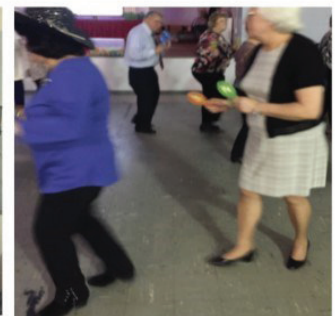
