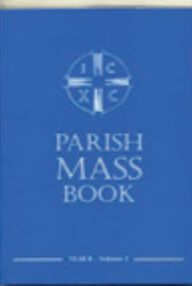


STEWARDSHIP

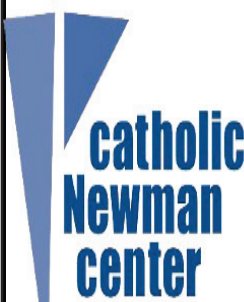



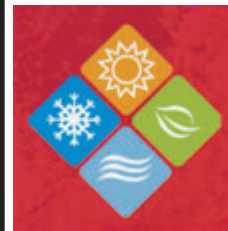
