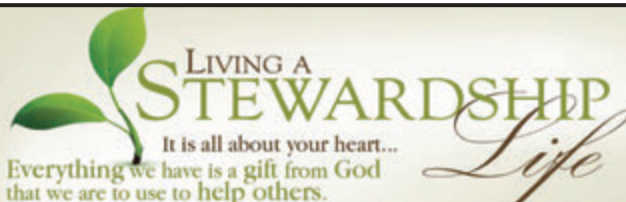

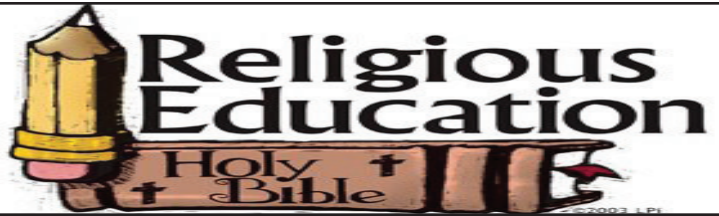
On Saturday, June 16th the **Knights of Columbus**

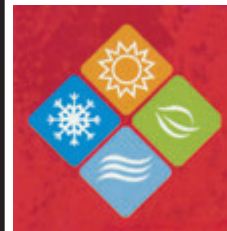
