The FRANCISCAN MISSIONARY SISTERS OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY, (FMIHM), is a Community founded by Blessed Mother M. Catherine Troiani in Cairo, Egypt in 1859.

Mother M. Catherine was born in Giuliano di Roma on January 19, 1813. At five years of age, after a tragic incident at home that caused her mother's death, she was entrusted to the care of the semi-cloistered Sisters in Ferentino, Italy.

At the age of 15, Catherine received the habit of the same religious community with whom she had grown up and made her solemn profession in 1829. However, she always harbored in her heart a great desire to go to mission lands to gain souls for Christ.

Her missionary dream became a reality thirty years later in 1859 when the Apostolic Delegate to Egypt requested the presence of the sisters in Cairo. After overcoming numerous difficulties, Sister Catherine along with five other sisters left for the mission.

They arrived on September 14th, the first female Italian missionaries in the land of Pharaoh.

Cairo was the first home but as other women joined them the community grew and spread to other lands. They are now present in Egypt, Italy, Malta, Israel, Palestine, Lebanon, Syria, Iraq, Africa, Brazil, China and the USA. Their apostolate covers a wide variety of service from education to health care to pastoral care.

A representative of the Franciscan Missionary Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary will visit our parish the weekend of August 4th-5th to speak to us about their missionary work and elicit our help and support.

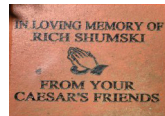
We currently have several bricks available on the path in the Memorial Garden. We would like to continue this tradition and fill the path with memorials

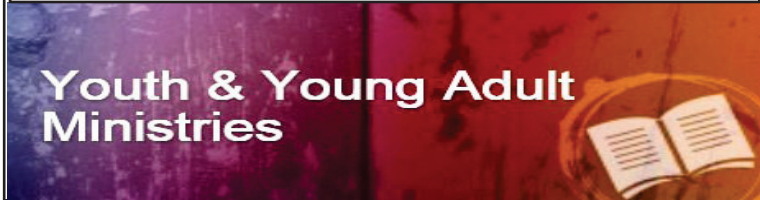

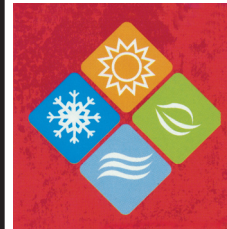
