Let this be an opportunity to celebrate our tradition of church teaching by going outward, strengthening our future and becoming Missionary Disciples of your Son, Jesus Christ, to the people of Atlantic, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester and Salem Counties. We pray that you watch over us and guide us as we invigorate our parishes and leadership, raise our public image, embrace our diversity, and continue to serve Your mission on Earth. Father, bless our campaign and send forth your Holy Spirit so that we will be for years to come **CATHOLIC STRONG**.

For the first time in nearly 30 years, the Catholic Community of South Jersey will hold a diocesan-wide campaign to raise needed funds for every parish and the select ministries of the Diocese of Camden. The diocesan component, which will receive 30% of the funding, will focus on the following:

Strong Schools - \$8 Million

Faculty & Staff development in the area of catechesis, curriculum expansion and innovation, capital improvements for elementary schools and more substantial methods for engaging youth and young adults.

Strong Service - \$4 Million

Providing care to individuals and families in need across Six counties through Catholic Charities, VITALity Catholic Healthcare Services and the Camden Center for Law and Social Justice.

Strong Faith - \$3 Million

Promoting the public image of the Catholic Church through traditional and newer media to highlight the vitality of our parishes and ministries. Increase educational opportunities for the parish ministers and staff to help our parishes embrace the varied expressions of the Catholic faith in language, culture, and practice, as well as their own professional and faith formation.

Of the funds raised, 70% will remain here at the parish. We were asked to identify a list of our unique needs and how we plan to put those raised funds to use. These needs may include renovations to the church or hall facilities, purchase of altar/sanctuary appointments/candlesticks, tabernacle/monstrance, hiring staff to expand Youth or Pastoral Ministries among other possibilities.

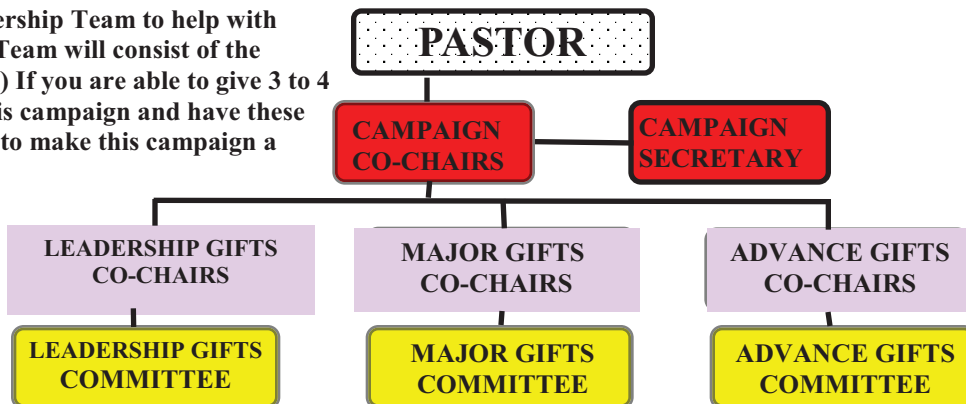

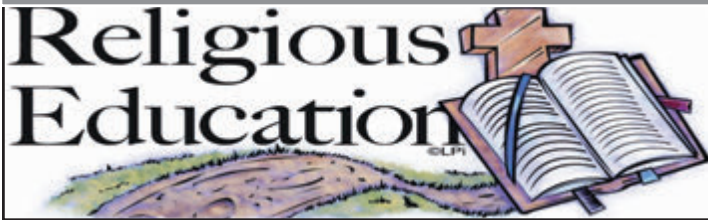

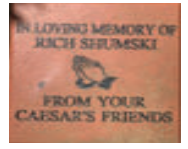


We currently have several bricks available on the path in the Memorial Garden. We would like to continue this tradition and fill the path with memorials for loved ones, family names and special

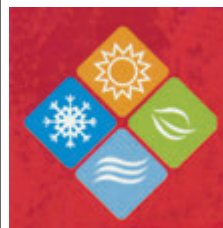
