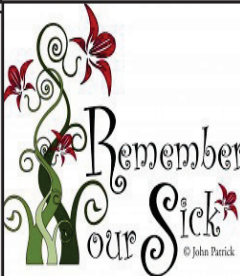

OUR LADY OF SORROWS' PLAN

The Catholic Community of South Jersey continues to reaffirm its commitment to promote the healing, redemptive and teaching presence of Jesus Christ to those seeking solace, forgiveness, and instruction. We have followed Christ's invitation to love one another, to be a community of faith, and to share our gifts in a spirit of stewardship and gratitude.

As vital and active members of the Diocese of Camden wishing to make our contribution, we are continuing the Catholic Strong campaign to provide the resources needed to ensure our parishes are financially stable, strengthen Catholic education, expand our outreach capabilities, and enhance our evangelization efforts. A successful campaign will ensure the vitality of our faith communities and ultimately meet the evolving needs of our diocese.

Every parish will share in these efforts with an allocated goal. Our parish campaign target is to raise a minimum of \$710,000, of which we will receive 70% (or a minimum of \$497,000), that will go toward parish needs. Additionally, we will receive 80% of all funds raised over our parish target, and we will use our share to address the following:

- ◆ Repave, seal and line Church parking lot and Hall lot - (\$53,000)
- ◆ Purchase/Memorialize Monstrance displaying 5.3/4" host - (\$3,000)
- ◆ Purchase/Memorialize Altar Processional Cross and Base - (\$1,200)
- ◆ Replace Main AC Unit for Church (\$190,000)
- ◆ Renovate Usher's Room as Confessional/Adoration Chapel - (\$8,000)
- ◆ Purchase/Memorialize Church Carillon Bell Music Console - (\$5,100)
- ◆ Re-light church interior substituting halogen bulbs - (\$3,000)
- ◆ Replace hall flooring (\$12,0000)
- ◆ Replace existing Hall Ceiling Tiles with 2" panels - (\$12,000)
- ◆ Paint hall and replace upper ceiling level window glass - (\$17,000)
- ◆ Replace commercial carpet in four Annex Classrooms plus carpet stairway - (\$12,100)
- ◆ Replace hallway carpet with hardwood floor planking - (\$8,400)
- ◆ Add two Speco color infra-red dome cameras, monitoring - (\$2,800)
- ◆ Replace main hall exterior doors + side door/crash bars - (\$20,000)
- ◆ Add AC through-the-wall unit to hall Religious Ed Office - (\$5,000)
- ◆ Replace missing exterior steps handrail at Hall entrance and handrail repairs at church side entrance (\$2,400)
- ◆ Replace existing single bathroom in rear of church to include: New bathroom for women with (2 stalls, 2 sinks) and a new bathroom for men (stall, 2 urinals, 2 sinks) - (\$44,000)
- ◆ A portion of the funds will be allocated towards Debt Reduction (Assessments) - (\$100,000)

We will receive a disbursement of our 70% collected funds during June and November, starting in 2019.

The Catholic Strong committee consisting of parish volunteers are reaching out to Phase 1 parishioners asking them to prayerfully consider supporting this important campaign. \$158,650.00 has been pledged so far toward our \$710,000.00 goal to enable us to make the necessary repairs and purchases needed for Our Lady of Sorrows Church. Personal meetings between generous parishioners and Fr. Harte or a team member will be completed shortly.

Grade One students completed a science unit called Patterns in the Sky. Students shared their knowledge during a spectacular jeopardy tournament in our classroom using Smart board technology.

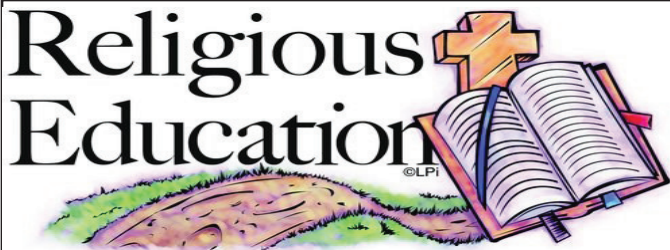
Second grade is preparing to experience God's loving forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation in parish workshops and classroom activities. May God continue to bless these students and families.



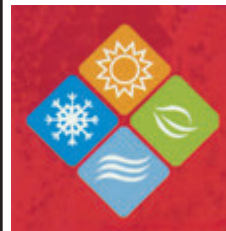

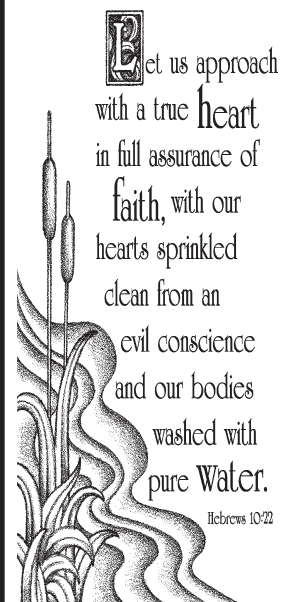
