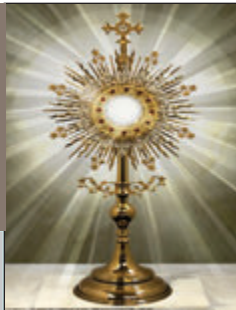

# Lenten Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence



## Lenten Fasting

Allows for a single "normal" meal. Sustenance through the day is permitted but the quantity of food for this sustenance is not to equal or exceed the amount of food taken in the single normal meal.

## Fasting

Catholics from the age of 18 to the age of 60 are bound to fast.

## Abstinence from Meat

Catholics over the age of 14 are seriously bound to observe abstinence from meat.

## Ash Wednesday

Is a day of **Fast and Abstinence**.

## Good Friday

Is a day of **Fast and Abstinence**.

## Easter Duty Obligation

After an individual has received First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.

### RESPONDING TO A CALL OF REPORTED SEXUAL ABUSE

If a parish, school or other diocesan location receives a telephone call in which the caller says he/she has been sexually abused by a Diocese of Camden

employee or volunteer, encourage the caller to call the **Atlantic County Prosecutor's office at 609 909-7800**. Next, encourage the caller to call the **diocesan number at 1-800-964-6588**. The individual who responds to this number is a mental health professional whose role is to assist victims of abuse by a diocesan employee or volunteer. Next, notify the pastor or principal or director of the telephone call. As a reminder, any calls from any media personnel must be referred to: Mike Walsh, Director of Communications at 856-583-6143.

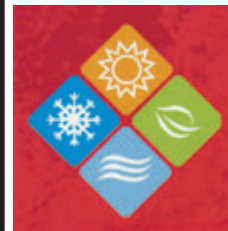


