# Lenten Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence

## Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

## Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of **one** full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

## Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in Lent)

All who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

## Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season

This weekend is Commitment Weekend for our diocesan-wide campaign, **Catholic Strong**. During all Masses, we will invite all families who have not yet been contacted to join us in participating in the **Catholic Strong** campaign. We ask you to consider a sacrificial gift to the campaign – one that is right for you.

Bishop Sullivan has asked each of us to consider a small amount each month over a three-to-five-year period. 

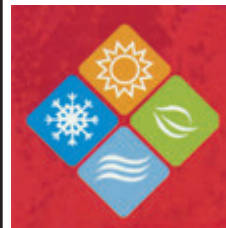

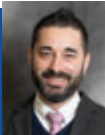
