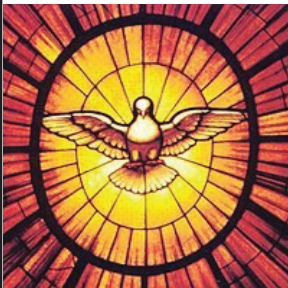

### Redemptoris Missio

Encyclical letters express the mind of the Holy See on matters of great importance. Pope St. John Paul's eighth encyclical (one of his few we've yet to study), *Redemptoris Missio* reminds us that the Church doesn't simply have a mission, but *is* a mission. Because its primary concern is not with social justice, this letter was largely ignored by the world media. Christianity is the "ordinary" means of salvation, a fact that the Pope felt it was time to insist upon with renewed vigor.

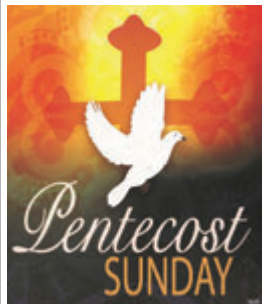

**DON'T FORGET TO WEAR RED TO CHURCH**

**for our celebration of Pentecost on June 9th.**

Pentecost is the only Sunday that we use red on our altar paraments to represent the power and fire of the Spirit. Pentecost signifies the coming of the Holy Spirit to the early followers of Jesus Christ and also recognizes the day that the church was established.

Pentecost always occurs seven weeks after Easter Sunday, 50



days after Easter. In other words, it falls on the eighth Sunday counting Easter Day. The English word "Pentecost" is a translation of the Greek word pentekostos, which means "fifty." Pentecost is an opportunity for us to honor the role of the Holy Spirit in our lives and celebrate the birth of the church.

Bishop Emeritus, Joseph Anthony Galante, died on Saturday, May 25. The bishop faithfully served the diocese from 2004-2013.

Bishop Galante, was born in Philadelphia and was ordained a priest on May 16, 1964. He attended Lateran University in Rome, where he received his doctorate in Canon Law in 1968, and the University of St. Thomas (Angelicum) in Rome, where he received his Master's Degree in Spiritual Theology in 1991.



He served in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia until he was named by Pope John Paul II in December 1986 to be Undersecretary of the Congregation for Religious in Rome. He was a member of the Pontifical Council for Social Communications and Chair of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops' Committee on Communications.

In October 1992 he was named Auxiliary Bishop of San Antonio, Texas. Eighteen months later he was installed as Bishop of Beaumont, Texas. He became Coadjutor Bishop of Dallas in January 2000.

On April 30, 2004, Bishop Galante was installed as seventh bishop of the Diocese of Camden.

For health reasons, Bishop Galante retired on January 8, 2013 as Bishop Emeritus of the diocese.

Eternal rest grant unto him, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon him.

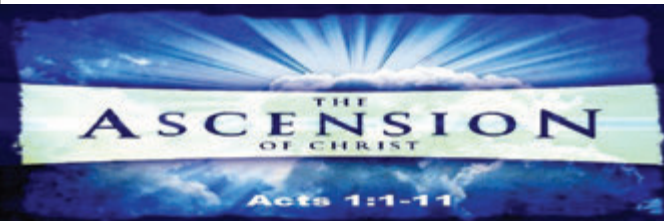

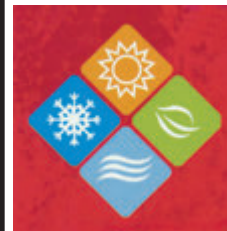
