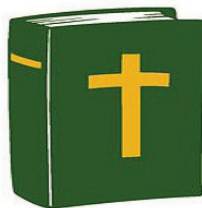

Our primary focus this summer will be one encyclical: **Redemptoris Missio**

Encyclical letters express the mind of the Holy See on matters of great importance. Pope St. John Paul’s eighth encyclical (one of his few we’ve yet to study), **Redemptoris Missio** reminds us that the Church doesn’t simply have a mission, but is a mission. Because its primary concern is not with social justice, this letter was largely ignored by the world media. Christianity is the “ordinary” means of salvation, a fact that the Pope felt it was time to insist upon with renewed vigor.

NEWS & EVENTS IN & AROUND the *DIOCESE*



Each year dioceses around the country arrange special events to highlight the importance of defending religious freedom. Religious Freedom Week takes place from June 22-June

29th each year. It begins with the feast day of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher, includes the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, and ends with the feast of Saints Peter and Paul. This year, the week also includes the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) and the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. • The theme for this year is Strength in Hope. It is taken from the Second Vatican Council's Decree on the Apostolate of the Laity: They who have this faith live in the hope of the revelation of the sons of God and keep in mind the cross and resurrection of the Lord. In the pilgrimage of this life, hidden with Christ in God and free from enslavement to wealth, they aspire to those riches which remain forever and generously dedicate themselves wholly to the advancement of the kingdom of God and to the reform and improvement of the temporal order in a Christian spirit. Among the trials of this life they find strength in hope, convinced that "the sufferings of the present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory to come that will be revealed in us" (Rom. 8:18). (Apostolicam actuositatem, 4). Catholics face challenges both in our current political climate of polarization and within the Church. We want to encourage Catholics to persist in the struggle to participate in the advancement of the kingdom of God by finding hope in Jesus Christ.

We are called to follow Christ as missionary disciples by seeking the truth, serving others, and living our faith in all that we do. 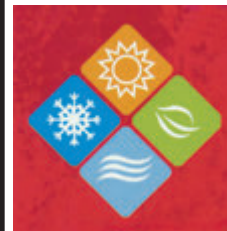
