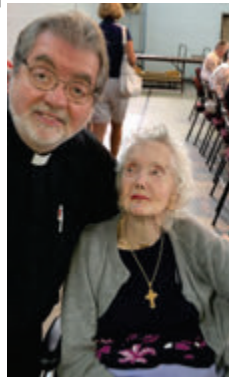
June is seated the second from the left and surrounded by her Legion of Mary sisters after reciting the Rosary and Legion prayers.

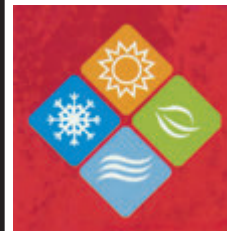
