SILVER AND GOLD

The Parish Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is being celebrated next Sunday, September 15th during each of the Masses followed by Hospitality in the Annex Classroom.

The highlights of this year’s celebration focus on two milestone events in the life of our Parish: one event is GOLD, the other SILVER.

2019 marks the GOLDEN (50th) Anniversary of the laying of the Church’s Cornerstone, and the celebration of Mass in the completed Church. Prior to our incorporation as a new Parish, we had been part of the Parish of St. Joseph in Somers Point. Now we embarked on creating a new faith community here in Linwood, stretching from the southern border of St. Peter’s Church in Pleasantville to the northern border of Somers Point and westward into Egg Harbor Township.

Initially, the Parish Hall was constructed, providing space for the celebration of Mass as well as all other parish activities! After Mass, the stage curtain was closed concealing all the altar furnishings, while the tables and chairs were reset into whatever configuration was needed for the next event. Some of you took an active role as parishioners of this new Parish and through your prayers, faithfulness and financial sacrifice helped the fledgling Parish to begin to establish its roots and Eucharistic presence here in Linwood. The dedicated services and priestly presence of the Missionaries of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary were present at the outset. Their Religious Order was entrusted with the care and pastoring of the new Parish as approved by the Bishop of the Camden Diocese. This leadership continued for forty-four years until February, 2013 when our Bishop transferred the pastoral care and leadership of the parish of Our Lady of Sorrows back to the Diocese. Fr. Paul Harte was appointed the first Camden Diocesan Priest Pastor of our parish in February 2013, completing a first 6 year term of office and has been reappointed for a second term of office, through 2025.

2019 also marks the SILVER (25th) Anniversary of the establishment of Perpetual Adoration in our church. Many parishioners made a prayerful decision to offer one hour of adoration each week before the Blessed Sacrament. During each season, day or night, weekday or holiday the vigil before the Monstrance

continues. Individuals, couples, families even small groups find inside the church a place of comfort and peace in which they pray to the Lord, Our Blessed Mother and the Saints.

Often they light vigil candles and write their intercessions in the pages of the “Journal of Intentions” next to the sign-in roster on the rear wall of the church lobby at the bulletin board and reading lamp. Our Lady of Sorrows Parish has been providing this 24/7 access to people of faith throughout Atlantic County and beyond. Visitors have commented that they experience a new awareness of silence and have noted the dignified simplicity of the polished brass Monstrance which holds the large consecrated host, the Sacred Body of Christ, resting on a shelf above and behind the Main Altar, with the gold lamay fabric shimmering in the light reflected from the spotlight.

We can only imagine the number of prayers that have been answered over the years! We can be sure of this much: many graces from God have been showered upon our Parish and the people in our area as a result of hosting Perpetual Adoration for this quarter century. With your active participation, may we invite others to be part of Eucharistic Adoration. Even if you cannot sign up for a specific hour during the week, you are always welcome to make a visit, to read from your bible, say a rosary, recite your prayers, light a candle or visit with a favorite Saint as you walk the side aisles.

May this multiple Anniversary, our “Silver and Gold” milestones, remind us of the challenges to being Catholic in this current day. May we pray for one another!

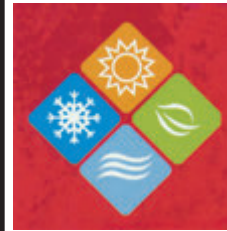
