Message from Pastor

Dear Parishioners,

Advent can become a type of “spiritual doorway” inviting each of us to explore for ourselves more of the richness of the lives of the December Saints. The feast of St. Nicholas, a 4th century Bishop of Myra in Asia Minor noted for his charity (Santa Claus) was observed on Friday, the 6th. St. Ambrose, Bishop and Doctor of the Church, is celebrated on Saturday, December the 7th.

The Feast of The Immaculate Conception, occurs on Sunday, December 8th (celebrated this year on Monday, Dec 9th) . This day is the Patronal Feast of the United States and of the Diocese of Camden which celebrates a truth which is unique to her alone. Mary was conceived without stain or influence of original sin from the moment of her conception in the womb of St. Ann, her mother.

On Monday, December 9th we honor St. Juan Diego, to whom Our Blessed Lady appeared in Mexico in 1531, leaving an image of herself miraculously preserved on the inside of his cloak. We have a framed portrait of St. Juan Diego’s cloak and the image of Our Lady hanging on the wall outside the Cry Room.

Please note the bulletin announcement of the 30th Annual National Night of Prayer for Life, held in our Church, beginning at 9pm Sun Dec 8 and concluding at 1:00am on Monday, Dec 9th.

Wednesday Evening, Dec. 11th: Advent Confessions in Church, 7-8:30pm. Multiple priest confessors will be available to hear your confession and to extend the mercy and forgiveness of God our Father.

Thursday, December 12th is the feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, honoring the apparitions of Mary at the hill of Tepeyac from 9-12 Dec. 1531 for the Aztec peoples. The Spanish name is rendered “Guadalupe”.

On Friday, December 13th, we observe St. Lucy, Virgin & 4th century martyr. She is the patroness of those afflicted with diseases of the eye and associated with the festival of lights in Scandinavia. St. John of the Cross, a 16th century Spanish mystic, Carmelite friar and priest is best known for his religious poetry and spiritual writings, including “The Dark Night of the Soul”, and is honored on Saturday, December 14th.

Listen for when we sing “O Come, O Come Emmanuel” and see in the verses the “O Antiphons” in anticipation of the Savior’s birth. O Wisdom; O Sacred Lord; O Flower of Jesse’s stem; O Key of David; O Radiant Dawn; O King of all the Nations and O Emmanuel. (cont’d.)

May the weekly lighting of the Advent Wreath candles be an indication of our willingness to be for others a reflection of HOPE. Please consider making a visit to the Blessed Sacrament and offer the Lord prayers of gratitude for all His blessings.

May we journey together with expectant joy and hope this Advent!

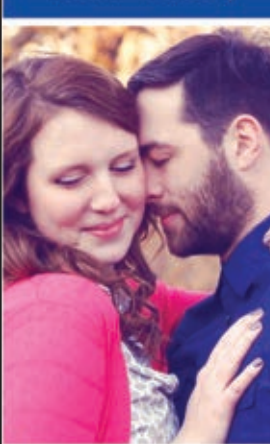
