PENTECOST

Let's say you need to talk to someone about something.

Or maybe you have a big decision to make.

One that will affect not only you, but your family, and possibly your friends.

Who do you ask for guidance?

When you're in need or in trouble, who do you turn to for help?

As Catholics, we should turn to the Holy Spirit.

But most of us forget to. Why is this?

We need the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity, and we need the gifts that He can give us. They apply to every part of our lives.

The Holy Spirit's seven gifts: Wisdom, Knowledge, Understanding, Counsel (Right Judgement), Fortitude (Courage), Piety (Reverence) and Fear of Lord (Wonder and Awe) are absolutely essential for getting to heaven...

...but too often we block their reception through our own faults.

We often fail to petition God to bestow these gifts upon us...


And we don't understand how these gifts can be strengthened in the sacraments.

It time to change that.

Let's take this Pentecost Sunday and pray to the Holy Spirit to enliven our lives with these gifts.

Parishes have received notice from the Diocese to prepare a specific plan for the gradual phased re-opening of our Church to celebrate Mass and the Sacraments. We are following the diocesan directives which will include sanitizing the church furniture, marking 6' distances on the floor and adding signs to wear a mask, etc. We will have hand sanitizing stations for your use on the way into and out of church. There is a strict regimen of protocols that we must put into practice before we open up. We will be in need of volunteers to serve as part of a Welcome Team. They will be in the lobby at the Entrance Door directing you to the hand sanitizer stations and assisting you in taking a seat in an available pew. Welcome Team members will direct you at Communion time and will be in place to guide you to specific exit doors for leaving church. We also need volunteers to help physically mark the floor for 6' distances, mark pews, put up signs and install sanitizing stations, remove unnecessary furniture, etc.

For every Mass we can only have 25% of capacity. Our Parish church seats around 500 people meaning that 125 people would be the limit for each Mass. As we have four Masses (Saturday, 5:00 pm, Sunday, 8:00 am, 10:30 am and 6:30 pm) we hope to accommodate those wishing to attend Mass. You will also need to wear a mask while attending Mass and observe social distancing at all times. At this time safeguarding the health and well being of our parishioners is a priority. Between Masses pew hand surfaces will be sanitized. The cry room will not be available and the Rest Room will be for Emergency use only.

As soon as we have a date for opening, we will let you know. For now join Fr. Harte remotely for Sunday Mass by visiting Our Lady of Sorrows website: www.ourladyofsorrows.us, and selecting our **Face Book or YouTube** page.

Giving you the opportunity to receive Jesus in the Eucharist will be a most welcomed gift. Weekday Mass and confessions will be returning soon.

Thank you for continuing to support our church financially by using your collection envelopes which you can mail to the office or put in the lock box in the rear of the church.

Be mindful of these 4 points:

- The obligation to attend Mass is still “Lifted” by direction of Bishop Sullivan.
- You must not come to Mass if you are sick, have a fever or chronic cough, etc.
- You should not come to Mass if you are over 65 and have underlying health conditions which put you at greater risk.
- You can stay home if you feel uncomfortable in anyway about being in the church building, in or around people at this time.
