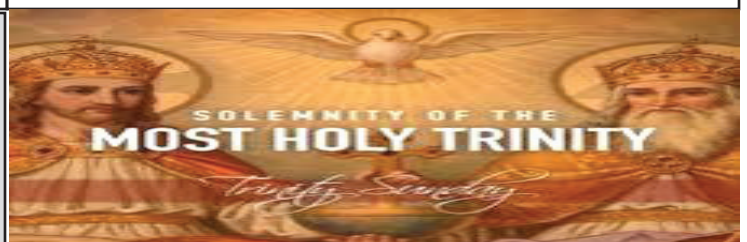
The Office of Religious Education is aware that there are some who are concerned about in-person instruction during the academic year (September, 2020 to June, 2021).

Dear Parishioners,

June, 2020

The Bishop has announced the effective RE-OPENING DATE of our Churches for Public Mass: the weekend of June 13-14th . Daily Mass, may begin as of Tuesday, June 9th. Giving you the opportunity to receive Jesus in the Eucharist will be a most welcomed gift.

There are significant limitations based on church capacity, the observance of 6' social distancing, active use of hand sanitizing stations and sanitized cleaning of the church surfaces.

Be mindful of these 4 points:

- 1) The obligation to attend Mass is still "Lifted."
- 2) You must not come to Mass if you are sick, have a fever or chronic cough, etc.
- 3) You should not come to Mass if you are over 65 and have underlying health conditions which put you at greater risk.
- 4) You can stay home if you feel uncomfortable in anyway about being in the church building, in or around people at this time.

Remember masks must be worn, hands sanitized, 6' social distancing required on sidewalks, lobby and inside all areas of the church. Limited capacity: 25% = 125 people. Seating will be as follows: 2 empty pews between 1 seated pew, with 3 persons being accommodated or/ 2 couples. All who enter will be counted so as to guarantee that we DO NOT EXCEED 125 individuals. Please be aware and understand that we are obligated to follow these regulations for everyone's health and safety! Volunteers will be needed to sanitize pew top surfaces, the "emergency use only restroom" and other touched surfaces before each Mass.

**Volunteers in the Welcome Team** will assist you upon arrival. Use hand sanitizer and you will have assistance in finding an available seat. No hymnals or Missalettes will be available. The reception of Holy Communion will take place once Mass has ended. Form a single file line in the center aisle, keep 6' distance and then break off to the left or right side to receive Communion in the hand. Remove your face covering before you arrive at the Communion Station. You will Exit the Church from the doors marked EXIT. **The Cry Room will be locked and access to the Restroom limited to "emergency use only"**. Please use your home facilities before arriving at church.

**We ask you to volunteer** for these set up jobs: to physically attach the vinyl 6' space decals to the floor surfaces; to lay duct tape markings along the walkways outside, and to set up the sanitizer stations inside the church. In addition, hymnals need to be removed and boxed and missalettes discarded to recycle.

- 4) Sunday 10am This Mass will be live-streamed, replacing the 10:30am time we followed during the closure period
- 5) Sunday 6:30pm

#### **Weekday Mass**

- 1) 7:45am Monday through Friday, Capacity limited to 10 persons
- 2) Tuesday evening 6:30pm followed by St. Anthony Novena, relic veneration
- 3) Saturday Morning Mass 8am

On Sunday, June 7 Private Mass will be livestreamed at 10:30am to FACEBOOK ourladyofsorrows.us and then to YOUTUBE. Public Sunday Mass resumes Sunday, June 14th. Plan on arriving early to guarantee a seat. Once we reach capacity, our Welcome Team will invite you to attend a later Mass or to watch Mass at home. As your Pastor, I take seriously my obligation to adhere to these policies as directed by Bishop Sullivan and I earnestly ask for your cooperation. These restriction will remain in place, at every Parish Church, until further notice.

As you face financial planning decisions, so does Our Lady of Sorrows. We are asking for your continued financial giving to our Offertory. We ask you to mail your offertory collection to the parish or place them in the labeled box at the baptismal font in the rear of the church. Your continued faithful support is more than ever, both critical and deeply appreciated.

Looking forward to sharing the Holy Eucharist together.
