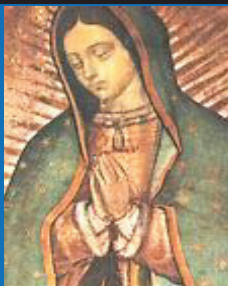

Stephen A. Beddia graduated from Westminster Choir College in 1974 with a BME Degree. Post graduate studies continued at Rowan University, Westminster Choir College and Rutgers University. Steve was in Vocal Music Education from 1974 until 2010 when he retired from the Egg Harbor Township School System. He conducted the South Jersey Junior High Chorus in 1993 and 2006. He served as Organist/Choir Director at St. Lawrence Church in Lindenwold from 1974 to 1990. Steve was the Founder and Director of the Camden Diocesan Choir from 1976 to 1988. He is also a published music arranger and composer. Currently, Steve is Organist/Choir Director at Our Lady of Sorrows Church in Linwood, where he has served since 1991. He is also a pipe organ builder, servicing pipe organs in the tri-state area. This is page one of two features highlighting Steve over his almost 30 years of music in our Diocese.



A note from a friend.....

I go back to Saint Lawrence Parish in Lindenwold, where Steve Beddia was the Organist and Choir Director. Monsignor Madden, the Pastor at that time, asked Steve to form a Diocesan Marion Choir for our pilgrimages to the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. It was the very beginning of our Diocesan Choir. It was a fabulous choir and we were all very proud of the work Steve and all the choir members did. Steve Beddia also put the organ together at Saint Lawrence Church, which Monsignor Madden purchased from a Protestant church that was closing down. Steve, together with other workers, re-worked the whole organ and put it all back together and we had a magnificent sound coming from that instrument. At the time I was stationed at Saint Lawrence Church and I witnessed the blessing of the organ. Those were great days at Saint Lawrence and Monsignor Madden, the pastor, did an awful lot to promote good liturgical music and the choir was a large part of that. I wish Steve Beddia a blessed retirement and I am most grateful to all that he did to promote good liturgical music in our Diocese and for our Diocesan liturgies. God bless you Steve and thank you for all that you have done to enhance our Diocesan liturgies, especially at the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception.....*Fr. Anthony Mannuppella*
