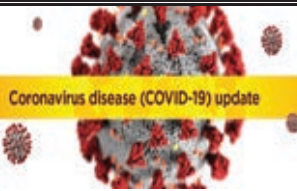
RELIGIOUS EDUCATION NEW FORMAT FOR FALL!

The portal is where the students and families will access the assignments, applicable videos, chapter reviews and assessments. The assessments are sent directly back to us once completed.
