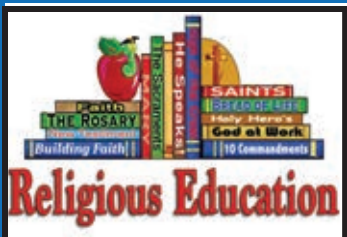

Dear Families

During this time of uncertainty, we remain committed to the health and safety of our Parish families. For this reason, we have

decided to offer remote learning for our Religious Education Program this fall. Each student will receive a hard copy of their book and have access to the digital portal *Flipgrid*. The books were distributed to parents at the end of September in the hall during two scheduled times.

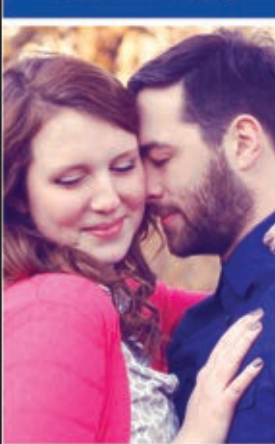
