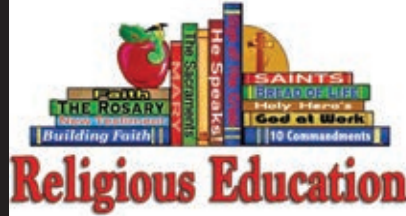
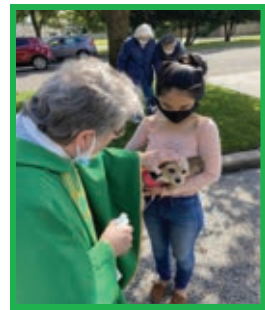

Dear Families

During this time of uncertainty, we remain committed to the health and safety of our Parish families. For this reason, we have decided to offer

remote learning for our Religious Education Program this fall. Each student will receive a hard copy of their book and have access to the digital portal *Flipgrid*. The portal is where the students and families will access the assignments, applicable videos, chapter reviews and assessments. The assessments are sent directly back to us once completed. 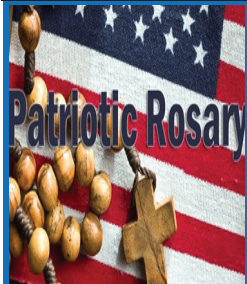

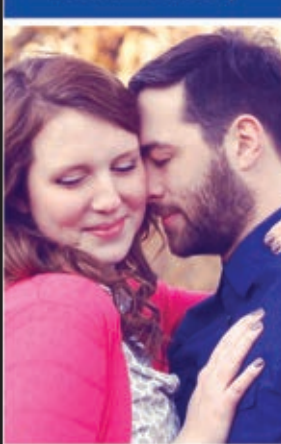
