GLORIA

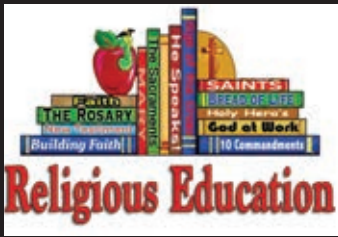

Dear Families

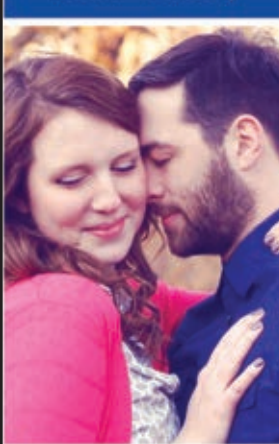
