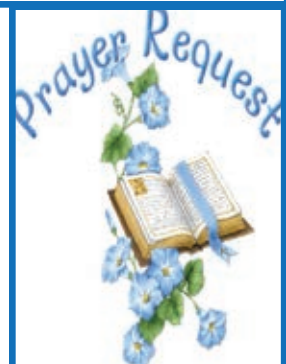

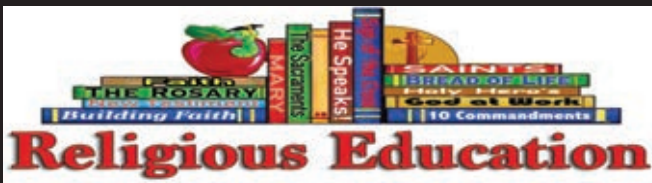

  4. Once we receive your donation we will mail out the Mass card.

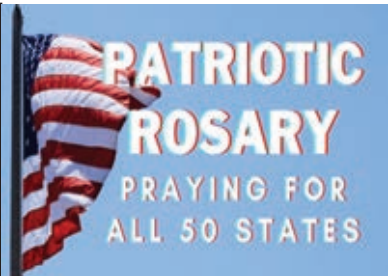

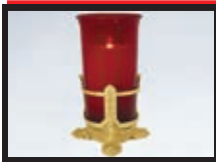

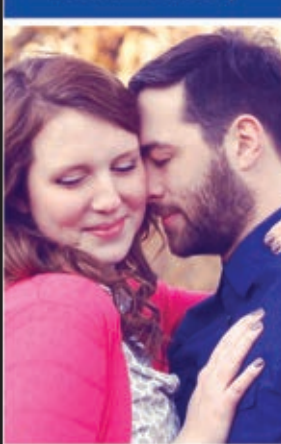
