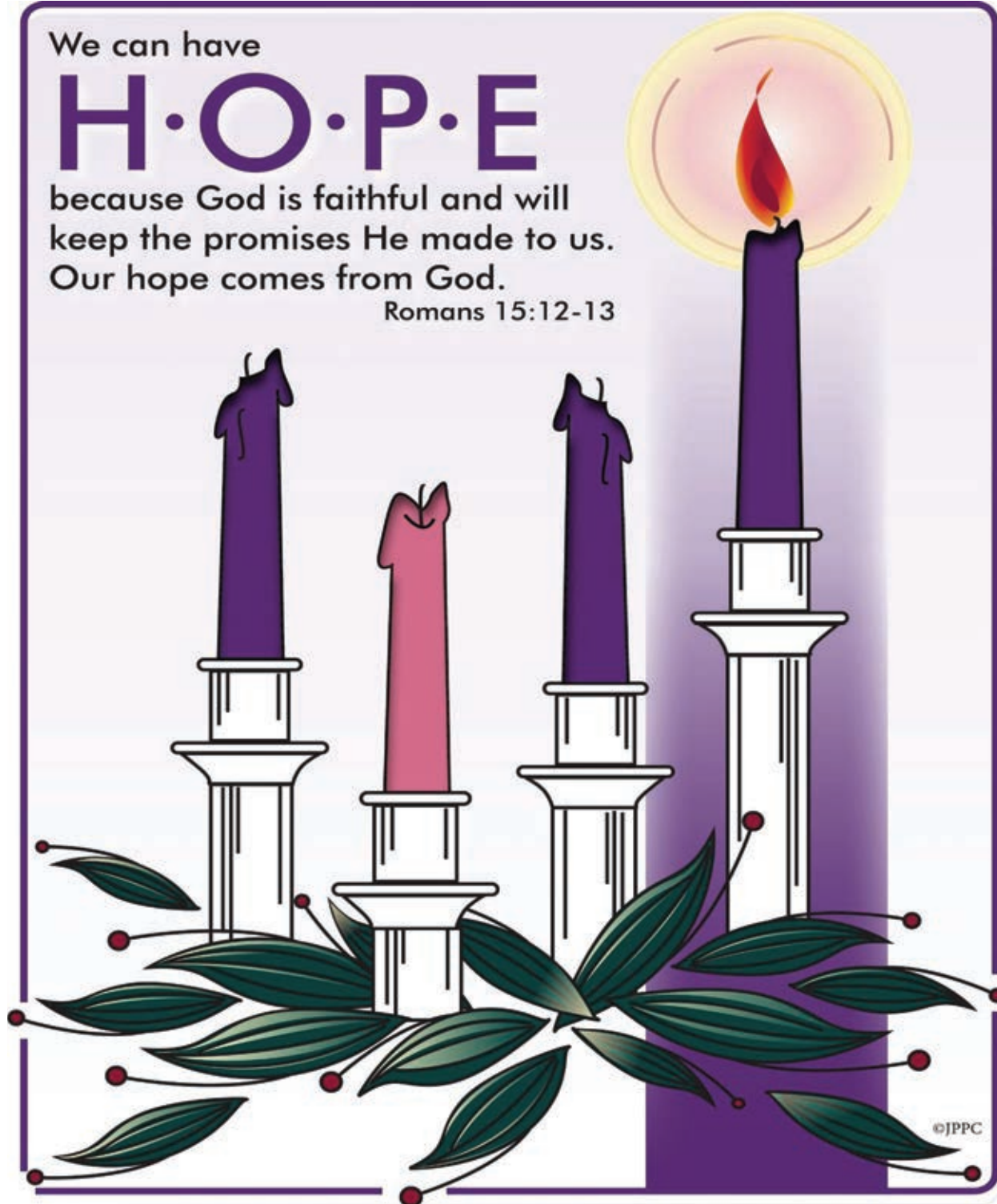

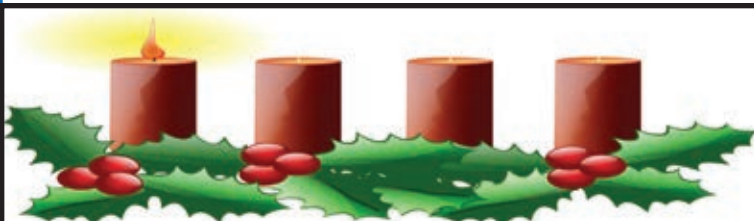

1ST SUNDAY OF ADVENT, NOVEMBER 29, 2020

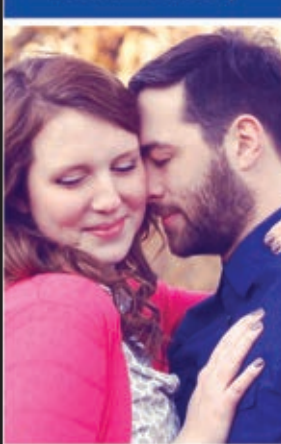
