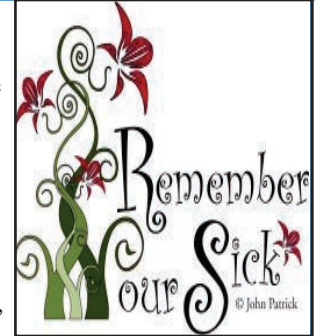

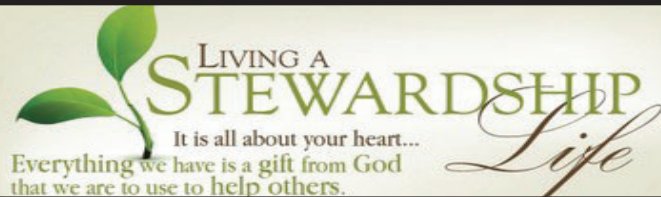

Great News! Thanks to the generosity of our Knights of Columbus Members, All Saints Council, who purchased and donated a Vector C100+ OLV Fogger machine, we have started sanitizing the church pews, seats, kneelers etc. following every Mass. This new electric fogging procedure replaces the manual disinfectant spraying and wiping down of the church pews which we have been doing for months.

The process of preparing, operating and cleaning the fogger is best handled by recruiting more two-person teams to add to the 6 men who assisted last weekend. This will help expand our teams and not overly burden anyone. The time involved: 15-20 minutes, following each Mass. On site training will be provided. **Catholic Bishops Urge Opposition to NJ's  
"Reproductive Freedom Act"**

**(Don't be fooled by the title – It's not freedom)**

This legislation if enacted would codify:· Allowing late term abortions up to birth; Permitting non-physicians to perform abortions; Elimination of any legislation requirements for parental notification; Elimination of any conscience protection legislation for health care workers; Mandating state taxpayer funding for abortion services; Prohibiting any future laws, regulations, etc. conflicting with this legislation.

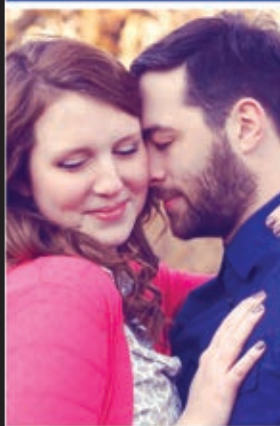
