




MARCH FOR LIFE PRAYER VIGIL

The Annual Prayer Vigil for Life will take place at Our Lady of Sorrows on **Tuesday, January 26th beginning at 7:30 p.m.** (following the 6:30 p.m. Tuesday evening Mass) with Rosary, Musical Reflection, and Silent Adoration until 9:00 p.m.



This Vigil takes place annually to coincide with the Anniversary of Roe v. Wade around this time and the annual March for Life in Washington, DC planned for the following Friday.

We pray together for the pro-life cause and the safety of the marchers in Washington, DC.

Catholic Bishops Urge Opposition to NJ's "Reproductive Freedom Act"

(Don't be fooled by the title – It's not freedom)

This legislation if enacted would codify:- Allowing late term abortions up to birth; Permitting non-physicians to perform abortions; Elimination of any legislation requirements for parental notification; Elimination of any conscience protection legislation for health care workers; Mandating state taxpayer funding for abortion services; Prohibiting any future laws, regulations, etc. conflicting with this legislation.

New Jersey Bishops in their statement on The Reproductive Freedom Act, "... urge all Catholics ... to reject this proposed legislative initiative in our state and to contact your State Legislators to vigorously express opposition to its passage."

Your action is needed NOW as this may come up for a vote in January! Contact your legislators and tell them to vote "NO!" on The Reproductive Freedom Act Senate/Assembly Bill - S3030/A4848.



Nationwide Prayer Vigil for Life—January 28-29

Catholics across the country are encouraged to observe a nationwide prayer vigil from **Thursday, January 28 to Friday, January 29, 2021** marking the 48th anniversary of the U.S. Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade and Doe v. Bolton decisions legalizing abortion through nine months of pregnancy. Since those decisions, over 60 million abortions have been performed legally in the United States. Each January, the National Prayer Vigil for Life is hosted by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops' (USCCB) Pro-Life Secretariat, the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception, and The Catholic University of America's Office of Campus Ministry to pray for an end to abortion and a greater respect for all human life.

This year, for the first time ever, in addition to the televised Mass, bishops in dioceses across the country will be taking turns leading live-streamed holy hours every hour on the hour throughout the all-night vigil. The vigil will begin with a live broadcast at 8:00 PM on Thursday, January 28 from the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. with a rosary, followed by Mass opening the National Prayer Vigil for Life.
