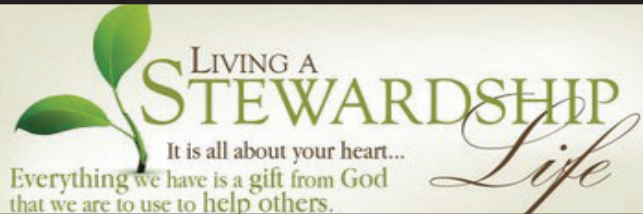

GLORIA

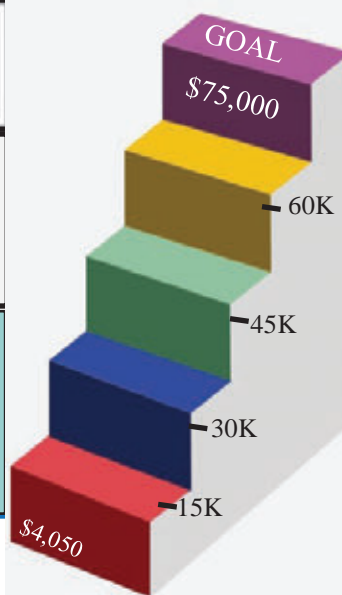

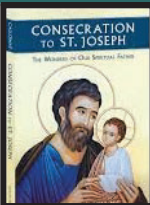

The Most Reverend Dennis J. 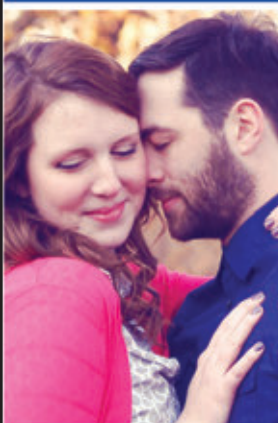
