THE ASCENSION OF OUR LORD

GLORIA

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God, almighty Father. Lord Jesus Christ, Only Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. FIRST READING:

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” When they had gathered together they asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?” He answered them, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

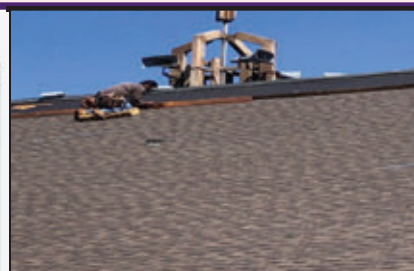
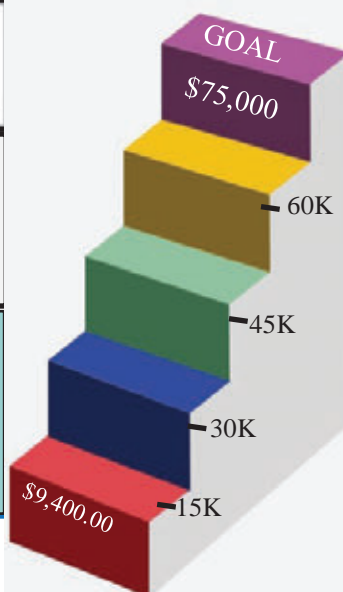

Letter from the Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

As Catholic Christians we continue to celebrate the miracle which is Easter: the glorious Resurrection of Jesus from the Dead! I am edified by the participation of so many of you during the Lenten Masses, devotions, Penance and visits to the Blessed Sacrament. You demonstrated a willingness to help make Lent a time for your own personal and spiritual growth. I pray that the Lenten sacrifices you offered up would return to you as moments of God's grace, to better realize His unconditional love for you in this world and at this moment. I was so pleased to witness the increased number of people who attended the Easter Liturgies. I am encouraged to see the increasing number of parishioners attending Masses on the weekends and at daily Mass. For instance at the Sunday 8am Mass on Mother's Day, we counted 120 in attendance!

Religious Education & Family Faith Formation

We celebrated Our First Holy Communion Mass on Sunday April 25 for our 13 Communicants and their families. Each family assembled a Banner project to mark their family pew for the occasion. The symbols of the Eucharist host, grapes, chalice and the altar were complemented with the child's name proudly lettered on the banner. The entire class gathered to crown the Blessed Mother as "Queen of the May" and to present a red rose for Her into the vase at her feet.. We offer our gratitude to Betty Napoli, our Religious Ed. Coordinator for all her dedicated hours of service to the families in our Program, helping them to negotiate the "virtual learning" this year through her expertise in Flip Grid and her willingness to track our students learning and completion of the chapter assignments.

Confirmation Prep

The 8th Grade students have completed their twice a month Sunday afternoon class sessions begun last Fall (2020). Our catechists are: Tom Salerno and Mr. Paul & Mrs. Kathy Savini. Students needed to attend 10 of the nearly 15 sessions offered. They were required to write an essay describing the personality and virtues of the life of the Saint whose name they will take at Confirmation. Each student will be interviewed personally by Fr. Harte or Deacon Joe, to assess their knowledge of the faith and teachings they have studied since 1st grade and to encourage them to be open to receiving the "gifts of the Holy Spirit". We anticipate receiving a date for a Fall 2021 Confirmation (possibly during October).

We would like to be able to offer IN PERSON, CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION for Religious Education Gr. 1-8 starting in the Fall, if catechists can be recruited and if the plan would be supported by our parents and families.

Church Upgrades & Planned Construction for 2021-2021

The entire new Church roof was replaced in April, the week after Easter! It was a major job and during the process, hidden and excessive rot damage was uncovered on one side. It required new plywood sheeting to be installed prior to the protective barrier and new shingles. The shingles color matches that of the roof over the Annex. Additional rain gutters and caulking were installed where the church roof meets the Annex and walkway areas. This project was not included in the Catholic Strong Campaign of 2018, so we have taken a Loan from the Diocese for approx. \$ 75,000 to pay for this. This Roof Repair was an absolute necessity, as water has been leaking into the church for some time. In response to this financial burden of a Loan, I am appealing for your generous assistance. We have begun a Fund to Repay the Roof Loan. Should you wish to participate, mark your check or envelope clearly as a "Roof Contribution" and the monies will be placed in a restricted account. To date, over \$9,000. has been donated for this account! I am so grateful for your help with this project!

Planned Projects for late 2020 and 2021

Renovate the rear wall Confessional into a suitable Penance Room.

Renovate the "Usher's Room" into a Daily Adoration Chapel to seat 10 persons.

Renovate & Update the existing Restroom connected to the Cry Room to be Handicapped Accessible. We plan to add another, new Restroom, right beside the existing one.

Update:

We are actively recruiting volunteers to rebuild our Bingo Team so we can plan to re-start Bingo, perhaps in early Fall! Our former Coordinators relocated out of state and other team members have retired after many years of service. Melody Tull (a Team Bingo Veteran) has agreed to serve as Coordinator, when a large enough group of volunteers have agreed to assist!

Other Hall Uses:

We continue to explore how we can adequately provide for rental of our hall and classroom spaces. Some factors include: Janitorial and Maintenance issues, Supervision and Coordination of the Facility, etc.

May I express my gratitude to each of you for your financial generosity to our Parish throughout the year, and especially in the Easter Offertory Collection. We have many buildings as well as a sprawling church campus to maintain as part of our legacy here in Linwood. Our Church's stewardship of time, talent and treasure is entrusted to each of us, to do our part in helping our Parish grow and renew itself!

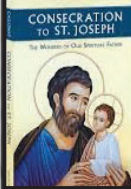

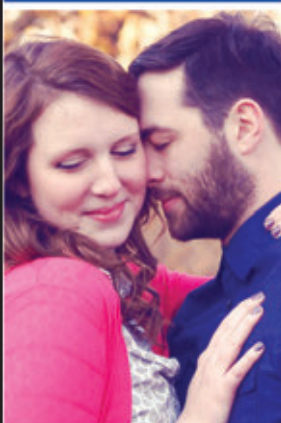
