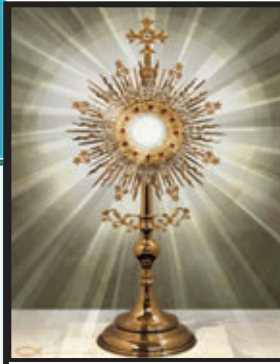


### The Spring Sprint Needs You

### Ministry of Consolation Training

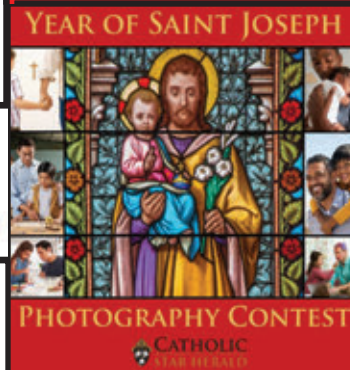

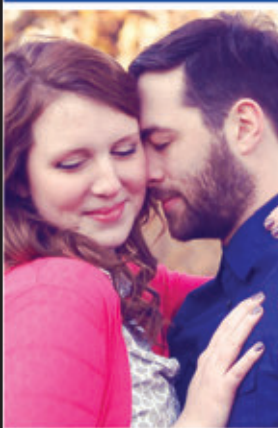
