



From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Looking back over the last month, the event of having a heart attack and having one stent placed inside one of my heart arteries, is an experience that immediately changes one's perspective on life. The event and its consequences, raise the level of awareness of the steps required to regain one's strength and endurance.

Watching what I eat (and counting carbs!) is now an exercise done before every meal. Taking a daily walk on the bike path is now an expectation to cover 3 miles per day (says my Doc). I've been prescribed several new meds to take which help to thin my blood, protect the stent and help address other health issues. I have finally managed to control my blood glucose readings, bringing them into my target range consistently. I will be delighted to find out what my A1c report will be in late August! I believe my life was spared by the Lord Jesus, Praise Him! And I am committed to living a healthier lifestyle going forward. I have shed 10 pounds, have "good facial color" and folks tell me I look great! I begin Cardiac Rehab in a few weeks. Please continue to keep me in your prayers. I am forever grateful to my two sisters, Patty and Mary, who supervised my "care and life reorganization" once I came out of the hospital and returned to the Rectory. I will always be grateful for their loving commitment to me and the sacrifices they made each day. I am grateful to our wonderful Parish Staff in the Office: Billie McClintock, Maryann Eger and Mary Doherty and to Deacon Joe who took over the month's Baptism schedule! I am grateful to the priests who agreed to help provide complete coverage of the Masses so that I could step back and begin to heal. Those kind priests are: Fr. John Perdue, Fr. Frederick Clement, Fr. Jim Durkin, Fr. Bob Matysik and Fr. John O'Leary. They were a "God-send" for sure! As of this weekend, I am returning to celebrating Mass, hearing Confessions, and working for limited periods in the Office. I am thrilled to see so many more of our parishioners return to participate at Mass and grateful so many have been vaccinated. We are a community of Faith and we stand united in our belief that Jesus is present among us.

May the Holy Spirit continue to guide each of us as we strive to walk daily with God. I wish you peace of mind and heart.


