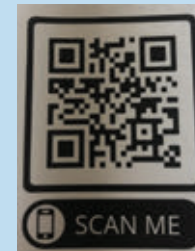

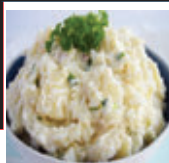

Dear Members of our Parish Community, September 15, each year, marks the Feast Day of "Our Lady of Sorrows", the Patronal Feast of our parish! And on this past Wednesday, the faithful daily morning Mass worshippers came together to celebrate with Fr. Harte our identity both as "children of God" and "children of Mary".

Our stately shrine statue of Our Lady of Sorrows graces the niche in the rear of the church, joined by a Messenger Angel, two cherubs and flanked by rows of devotional candles. She is visited throughout the day (and night) by the faithful who pray to her and light a candle for their intentions. Our Lady is robed in black silk but her face projects serenity. Her crown is golden, as is the trimmed hem of her robe. But look more intently at her body and we see her holy, maternal heart pierced with a dagger of suffering, linked to specific events she experienced as Jesus's Mother.

Referred to as the "Seven Sorrows" of Mary, they are as follows:

1. The Prophecy of Simeon your heart will be pierced. . .
2. The Flight into Egypt (to escape the murderous intent of Herod
3. The Loss of the Child Jesus in the Temple of Jerusalem (age 13, several days missed)
4. Mary's meeting with Jesus on the Via Dolorosa (not noted in NT) but represented by tradition in the Stations of the Cross
5. The Crucifixion of Jesus on Calvary
6. Jesus is taken down from the Cross
7. The Burial of Jesus by Joseph of Arimathea

Mary replied to the Angel Gabriel at the Annunciation "Let it be done to me according to thy Word" and she would come to embrace the fullest reality of what being a parent would entail. Our Lady is an ideal model for mothers and fathers. Our Lady was born without the effects of original sin. Our Lady was a devoted daughter to her parents Joachim and Anne. She was a cherished wife to Joseph. She will be ever honored as the Mother of Jesus.

Under her maternal protection, may our Parish continue to proclaim the Good News in Word and in Sacrament. May our recent return to offering "Perpetual Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament" in our church, be an invitation to all persons of good will and heart to enter into the presence of Our Lord in the Eucharist. May our devotion to Jesus and His holy Mother encourage us to be a people of praise, joy and hope for all of God's children through our faith and the practice of good works.

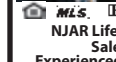
