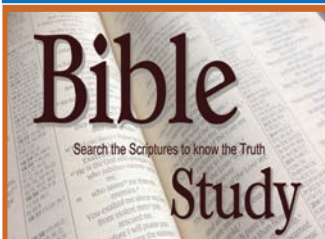
## The Parish

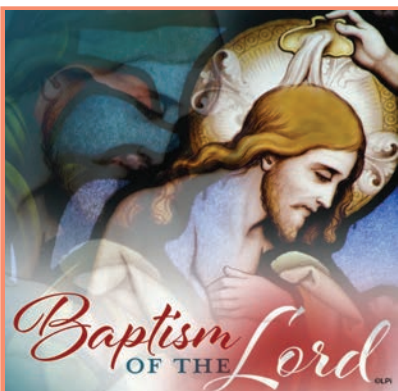
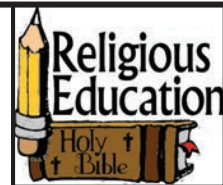

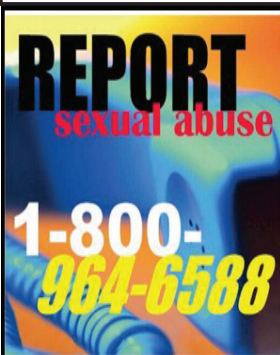
