**Your help is needed. Please call the office to volunteer.**

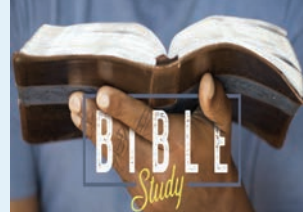

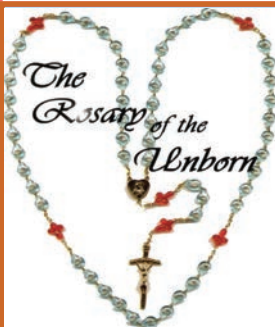
