


We are delighted to share a couple of improvements to our Garden Permit Program! First, in an effort to be more flexible and provide greater service, we have extended the Garden Permit to be a year long program. Additionally, we have added a new option, now called Garden Permit Prime, which gives families the option to select an enhanced landscape edging. The annual fee for the Garden Permit Prime is only \$50. The decision to offer both improvements is directly in response to feedback we have received from a number of our families.

Of course, South Jersey Catholic Cemeteries continues to offer the standard Garden Permit Program which includes black plastic landscape edging. We are happy to confirm that the annual fee for this option remains at \$35.

The Garden Permit Program allows for the planting of flowers in front of monument markers giving family members the ability to care for the final resting place of their loved one(s). These gardens are permitted under controlled circumstances and only where the spacing of the monuments allows for access of equipment. The Garden Permit Program begins every year on March 21, with the start of spring.

An application must be completed in order to participate in the 2022 program. Please note applications and payment must be received by March 15, 2022 in order to continue with the program for those who signed up in March of 2021.


