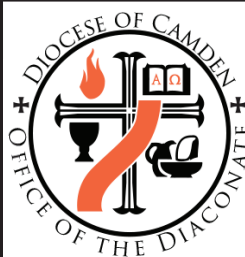

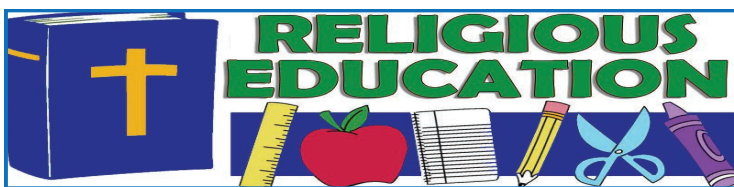
Outdoor Rosary in the Park

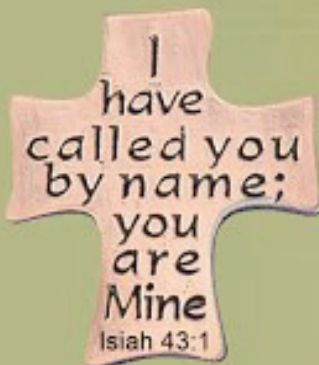

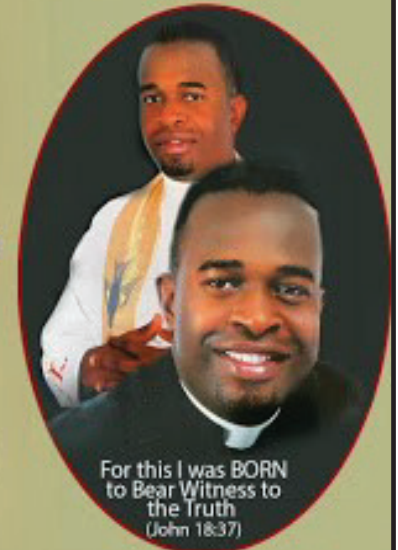
