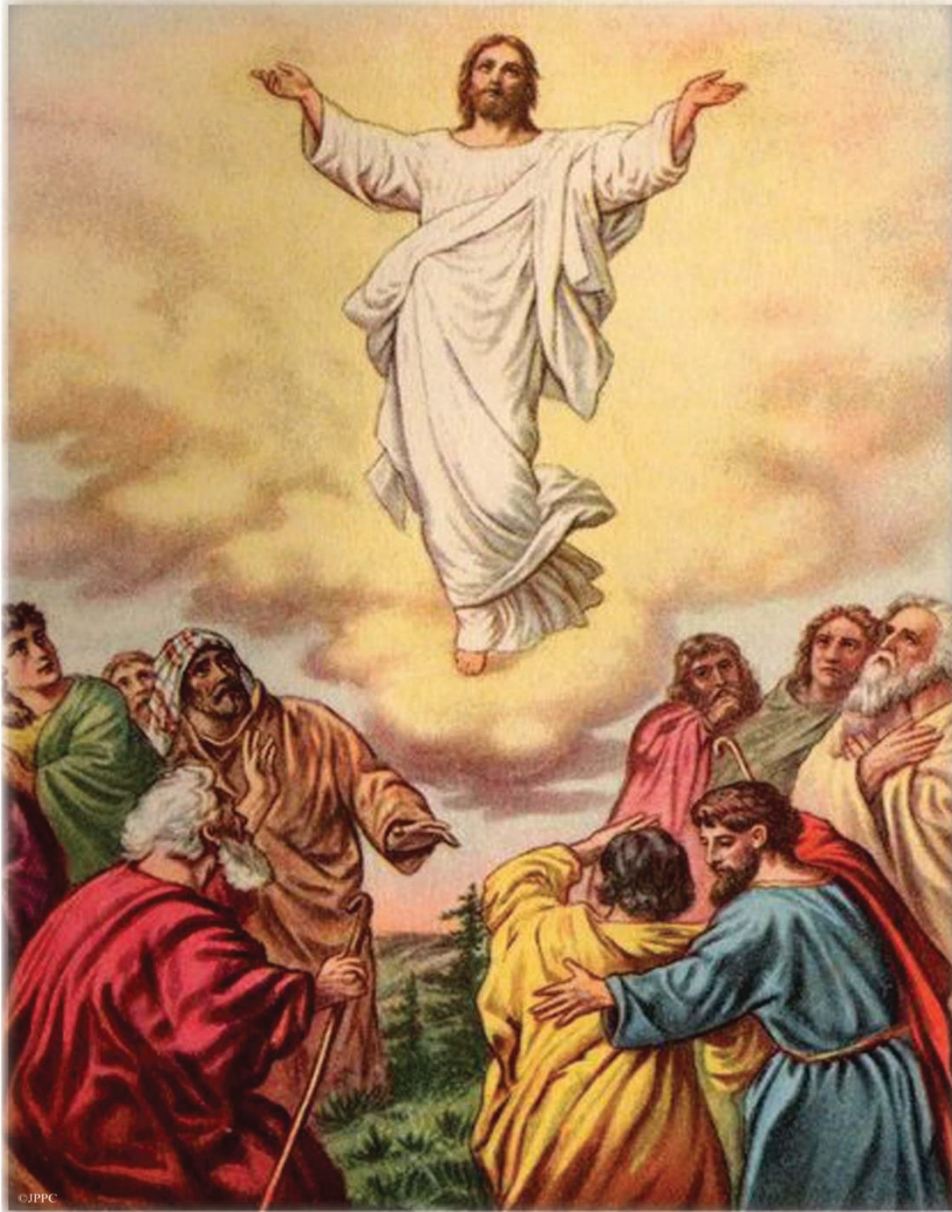


The Ascension of The Lord

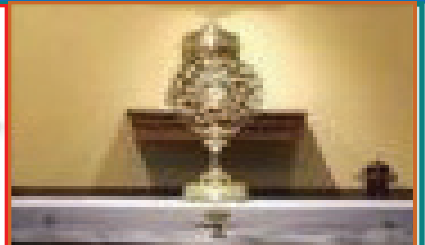

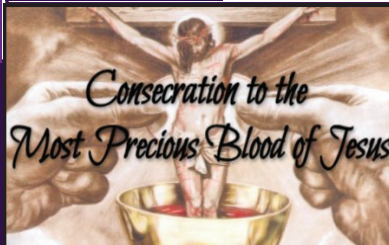
