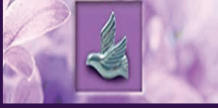

Austin Schuetz was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia in May 2011 when he was almost 3 years old. During his treatments, he required blood transfusions and eventually a bone marrow transplant.

"I had never given blood before until he was diagnosed, and I wish I had," said Austin's mom, Kimberly Schuetz, who is an oncology nurse at the hospital where her son was treated.
