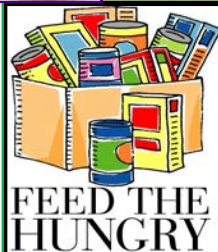

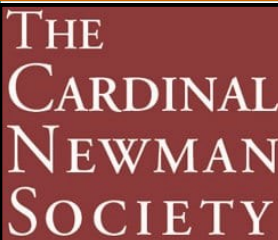

Newman Connection's High School Outreach Program keeps high school and college students connected to the Catholic campus ministry.

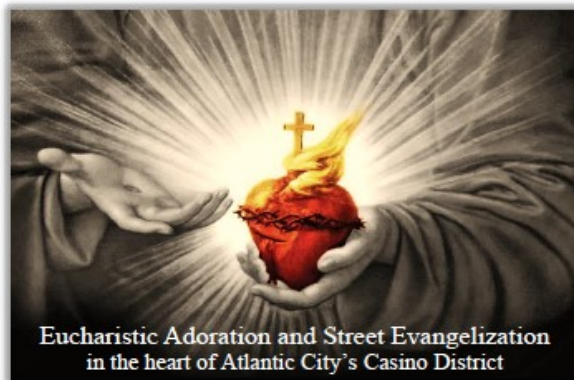
