2023 MARCH FOR LIFE
JANUARY 20, 2023 | WASHINGTON DC

The Knights of Columbus Araneo Chapter is partnering with Cape May County New Jersey Right to Life to sponsor a bus trip to the 2023 March for Life in Washington, DC. The bus is a first class touring coach with on-board restroom and will make very brief stops along the way for meals and bathroom breaks; there is no cost to passengers for the bus transportation, but riders are responsible for their own meals/refreshments and we ask at least \$5.00 each toward a tip for the driver.. Even with the wonderful blessing of Roe v. Wade being overturned, which allows more freedom at the state level to enact pro-life laws, the necessary work to build a culture of life in the United States of America is not finished. Rather, it is focused differently. The goal of the national March for Life is to not only change laws at the state and federal level, but to change the culture to ultimately make abortion unthinkable.
