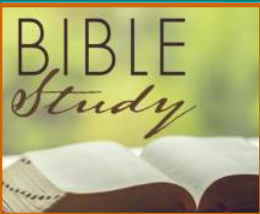

The Knights of Columbus Francis Araneo Chapter is partnering with Cape May County New Jersey Right to Life to sponsor a bus trip to the 2023 March for Life in Washington, DC. The bus is a first class touring coach with on-board restroom and

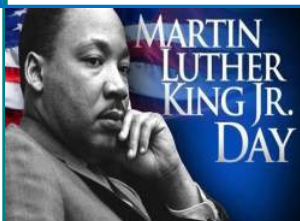

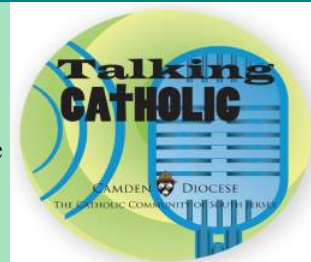
