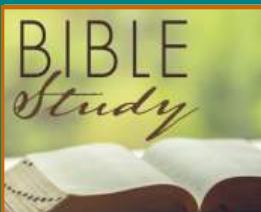

Stewards Deny Self

"Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." MATTHEW 5:3
