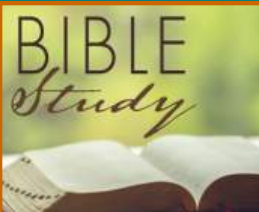

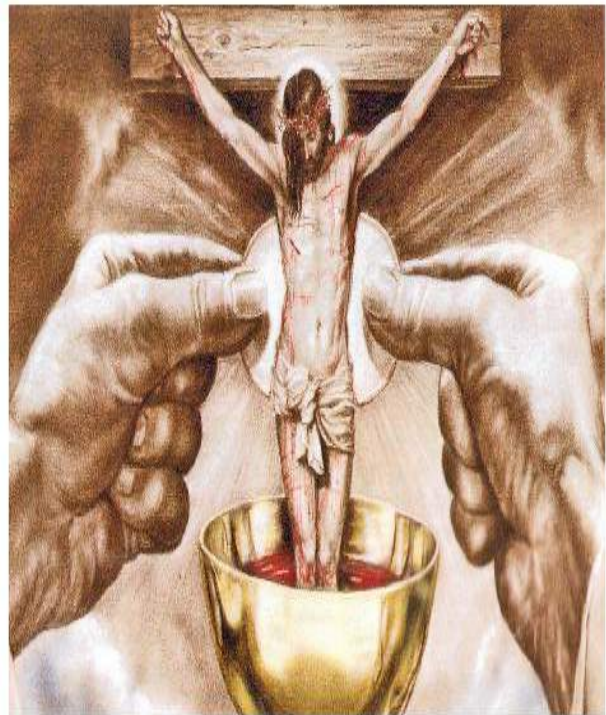

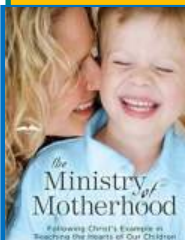

The Garden Permit Program allows for the planting of flowers in front of monument markers giving family members the ability to care for the final resting place of their loved one(s). These gardens are permitted under controlled circumstances and only where the spacing of the monuments allows for access of equipment. The Garden Permit Program begins every year on March 21, with the start of spring. Our Standard Garden Permit yearly fee will remain at \$35, and our Prime Garden Permit yearly fee will remain at \$50. Application must be completed in order to participate in the 2023 program. Please note applications and payment must be received by March 15, 2023 in order to continue with the program for those who signed up in March of 2022.
