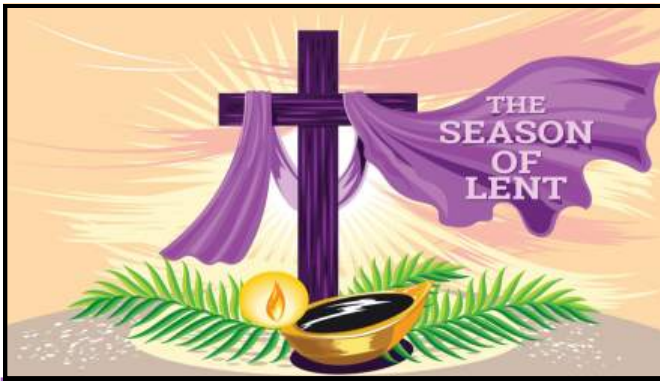

DAY of FASTING and ABSTINENCE

Weekdays of Lent:

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:

These are days of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of **one** full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

Days of Abstinence: (All Fridays in Lent)

All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation:

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not lim-

We have received a Dispensation from the Diocese, for Catholics (within the territory of the Diocese of Camden) on St. Patrick's Day, Friday, March 17th from the Lenten obligation to abstain from eating meat. Catholics who use this dispensation from meat should instead make another appropriate sacrifice on March 17th or abstain from meat on another weekday during the 3rd week of Lent.
