



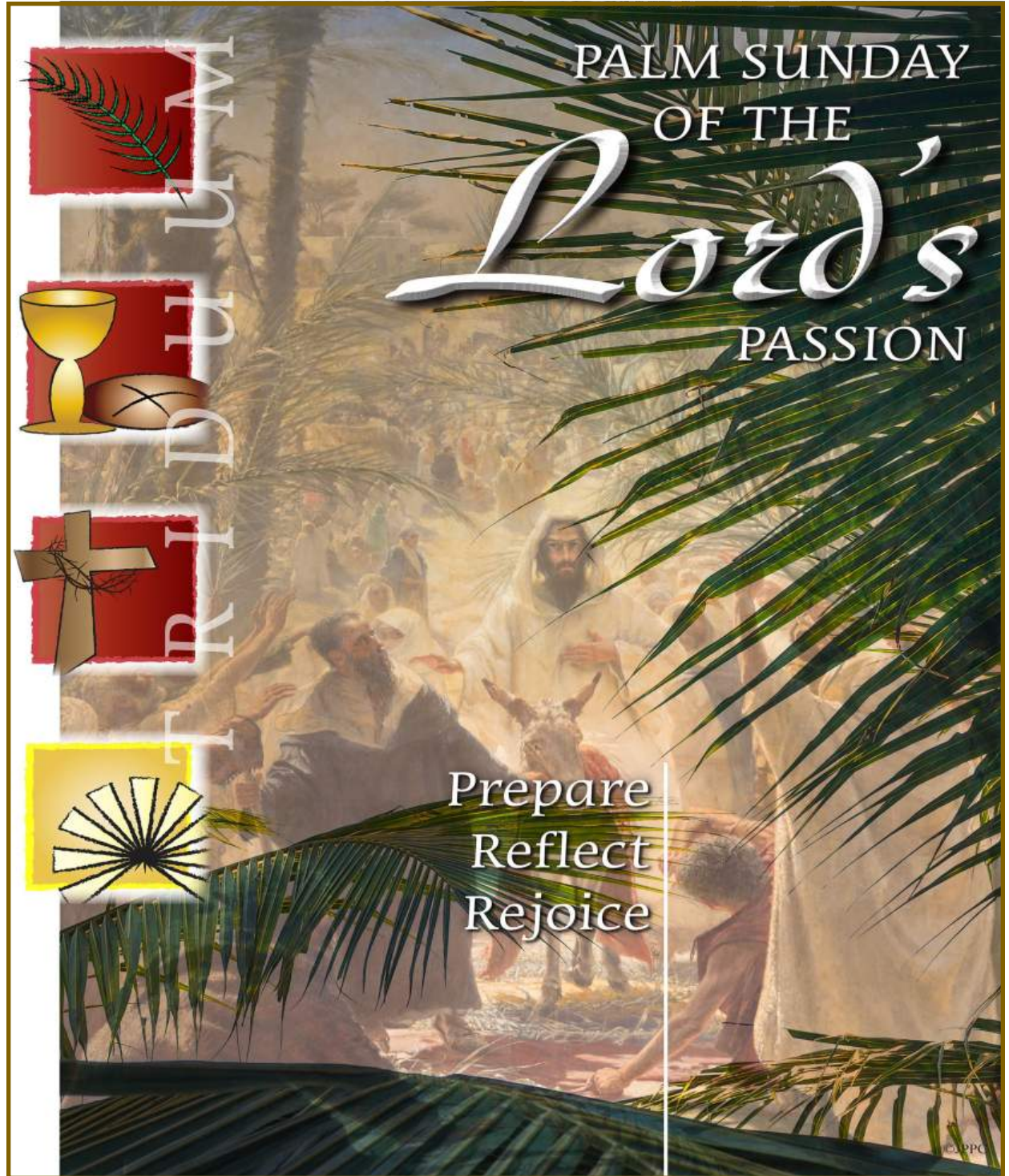

# **DAY of FASTING and ABSTINENCE**

## **Weekdays of Lent:**

There is no obligation to fast. However, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended.

## **Good Friday:**

Is a day of *Fast and Abstinence from meat*. There is a limit of **one** full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

## **Days of Abstinence - All Fridays in Lent**

All who have reached their 14<sup>th</sup> year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

## **Easter Duty Obligation:**

After they have received their First Holy Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess mortal sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.

The Easter Egg Hunt is scheduled for after the 10:00 am Easter Sunday Mass. All children 10 years old and under are welcome!

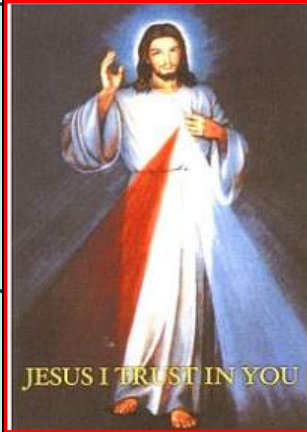
**Grateful Stewardship**
