## *From the Pastor's Desk*

My Dear Parishioners,

As Catholic Christians we continue to celebrate the miracle which is Easter: The Resurrection of Jesus from the Dead. A glance backwards confirms that our parish's Liturgies of Holy Week were well attended. On Palm Sunday, we received and waved fresh branches of cut palm. With music appropriate to the feast day, we gathered as a faith-filled community to recall Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem and to mark the beginning of the holiest week of the liturgical year. Holy Thursday marks the institution of the Eucharist as Jesus gave his disciples a new command or "mandatum" to serve others and to celebrate this meal as a "new covenant" ratified by the sacrifice of his body and blood as our Redeemer. Priests observe this day as our collective Priestly anniversary. Twelve members of our parish family came forward to have me wash and towel dry their right foot, as Jesus did for his apostles at Passover; a gesture of humility. In a procession around the church, I carried the Eucharist to the Repository Tabernacle, providing the opportunity for private prayer throughout the late evening. Good Friday, with the sanctuary stark and empty, we assembled to listen to the reading of the Passion, to bow in reverence before the feet of the Crucifix and to receive Holy Communion. The Stations of the Cross followed later that evening. Table foods for Easter were blessed on Saturday noon. At the Easter Vigil Mass we ignited the Easter fire and christened the new Paschal Candle, from which we lit our own personal candle as Believers! As Easter morning dawned, our morning Masses were very well attended, with standing room only attendance at the 10am liturgy. The children enjoyed the Easter Egg Hunt, gleefully retrieving over 2800 multicolored plastic eggs filled with candy! Most of us went on from here to attend family dinners, visit friends, go out for lunch or dinner. We offered the Divine Mercy Sunday Holy Hour, last Sunday, which included the veneration of a first class relic of St. Faustina Kowalski and incorporated the recitation of the Rosary, Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Benediction. Next on our Sacrament Schedule are the First Holy Communion Masses during late April and early May.

I wish to express my sincere thanks and appreciation to the many individuals and ministry groups who helped make this Lenten and Easter Season so abundantly rich and meaningful for all of us. They include: Fr. Cal La Verde, Deacon Joe Lonergan, the dedicated Parish Office Staff, Jennifer Salerno who produced the Mass broadcast, Mary Doherty, Betty Napoli and Linda Dunn and the Social Sodality who stuffed 2800 Easter eggs and coordinated the East Egg Hunt on Easter Sunday, Victor Mozdzan responsible for the online bulletin, Tom DiPatri, Tony Mazzeo, Craig France and Dave Reilly who hung the full-length art banners on the sanctuary wall, Choir Director Kim Shea, Kathleen Lewis, Organists Evan Shea and Jeffrey Seals, Members of the Choir, Musicians and Singers, Ushers, Greeters, Liturgical Readers, Extraordinary Ministers of Communion, Adorers of the Blessed Sacrament, acolytes, altar Servers, collection volunteers, candle ministers, catechists and aides, Susan Scott and the housekeeping and maintenance volunteers, Knights of Columbus, Parish Decorator Team Members who decorated the lobby of the church for Lent and Easter, Tom Salerno and Team for decoration of Holy Thursday Repository and Easter Sanctuary and Altar Flowers, Tom Di Patri, Dave Riley and helpers each and every morning for setting up. This year's beautiful Easter Paschal Candle is presented in memory of Harold "Hap" Applegat by his loving wife Joan Applegat and members of the family.

As "church", we proclaim ourselves believers in Christ's resurrection from the dead. May each of us continue our journey in "EASTERING" or EAST-STEERING. The term has a nautical flavor, as if we are in a boat navigating the various stages of our human journey towards Christ, the Light and hope of our world. As the sun rises in the East, we are invited to experience the joy and warmth of Jesus' love for us. May Spring provide you with opportunities for enjoying the beauty of nature around us. May Our Lord bless you and those you love.
