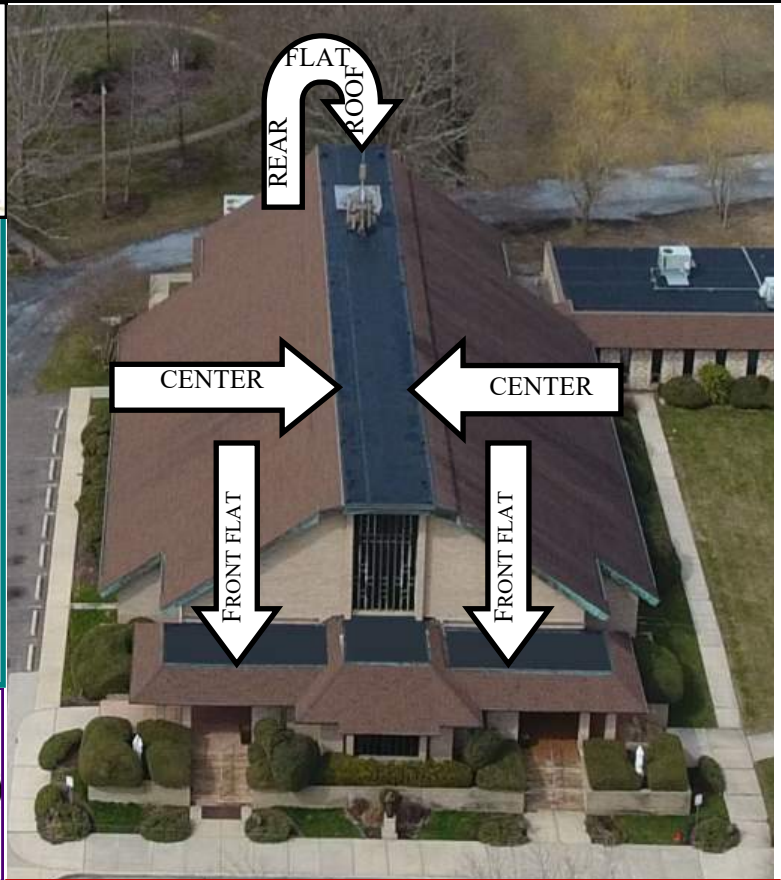
We need Bingo Volunteers!!
