I am so grateful for your prayers, your remembrance at Mass and for your cards and notes.

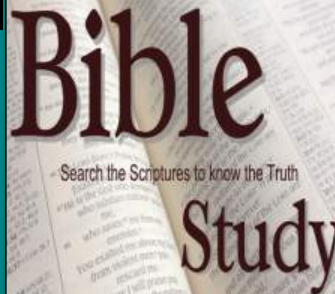

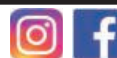

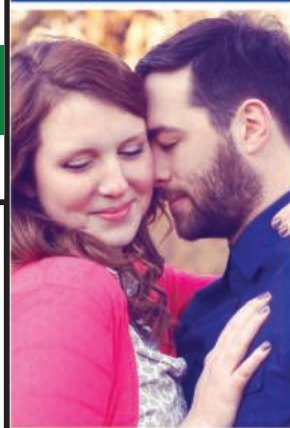
