Dear Parishioners and Friends,  
According to the calendar, schools have re-opened, student sports and extra-curricular activities are up and running. From my vantage point in the parish office, our church's activities, meetings, prayer groups, Religious Education classes and planning for annual Fall Social and Fundraising Events are already in the works! Read the remaining pages of the Bulletin and you will see the gamut of opportunities being offered here and in our region of the Diocese.

September Highlights: The opening night of Religious Education Sessions for Grades 1-8 is set for Monday, September 18th. Grades 1-4 meet from 4:45pm-6pm and Grades 5-7+Gr. 8 Confirmation students will meet from 6:15pm-7:30pm on most Mondays. Most Catechists have returned to serve but we are still searching for a Catechist for Grade 5 (approx. eight students). We provide support and coaching to Catechists to assist them in lesson planning and class supervision.

Wednesday, October 18, 2023 at 5:00pm Bishop Dennis Sullivan will confer the Sacrament of Confirmation for our students who are now Freshmen in High School. In anticipation of this, a special "retreat" program was brought in for them this past Thursday from 4-7pm. This Catholic Retreat Team provided a forum for interactive talks, video and other youth-centered activities to support their decision to deepen their relationship with Jesus Christ.

The Activity Sodality had their first meeting since the recent passing of its "energetic and creative" coordinator: Linda Dunn. Her enthusiastic spirit is already being picked up by the members who have begun planning for the Parish Annual 750 Club Raffle and Dinner on Saturday November 11, 2023. More details will be forthcoming. You will very shortly receive your flyer for this event. Make plans to purchase your \$40 ticket and share in the celebration.

Bible Study with Deacon Joe will focus on the Book of Revelation and will be held on Monday mornings, beginning September 18th at 10am in the Annex.

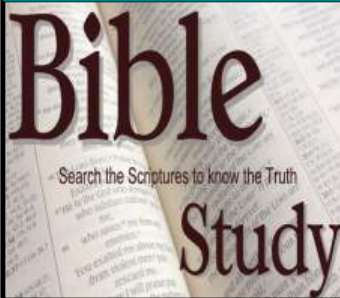

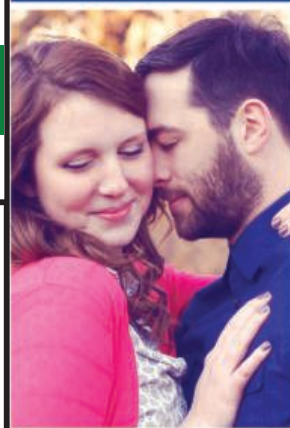
