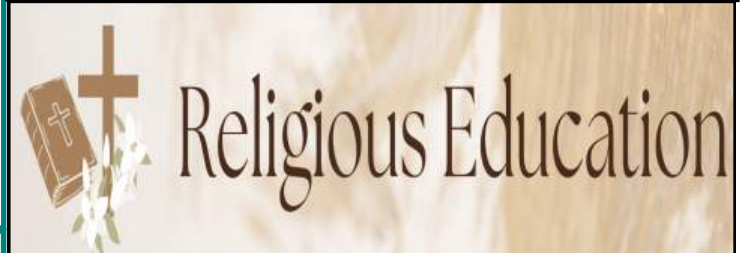

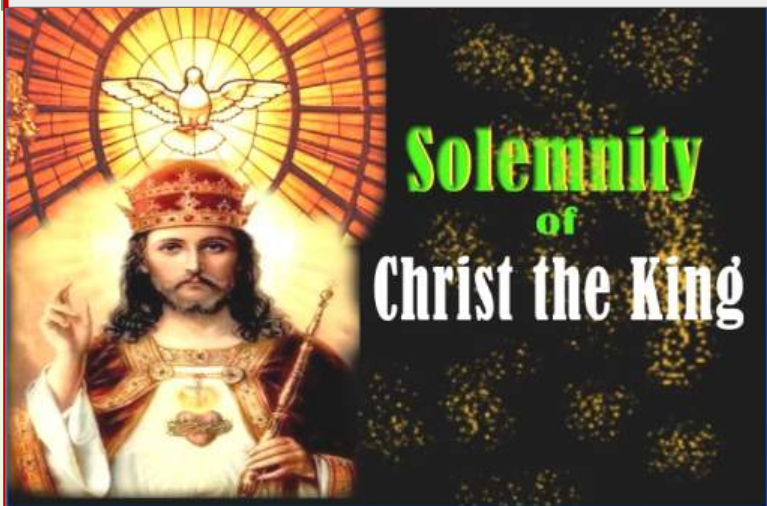

On Sunday, November 26th, The Feast of Christ the King, we will celebrate the opening of the new Adoration Room and Confessional. After the 10:00 a.m. Mass, there will be a blessing of the Monstrance and Adoration Room.

The room has undergone a full renovation with new lighting, new chapel chairs with kneelers, new carpet with freshly painted walls and ceiling. The electrical system was upgraded, an exhaust fan-ventilator fan was added with updated electrical switches. A secure closet was incorporated with an alarm system for use by our Sunday ushers who take up the collections.

A new floating altar shelf was crafted to hold the Monstrance during Adoration. The Monstrance is a stunningly new design executed in brilliant polished brass and adorned with ruby stones. A separate alarm will be in use to safeguard the Monstrance. A wall-mounted Crucifix and donated Sanctuary Lamp and Holder have been placed on the wall.

Lang's Nursery in Linwood generously donated Palm trees to our Church. We extend our thanks to them for thinking of us. Some were given to parishioners who asked for them.

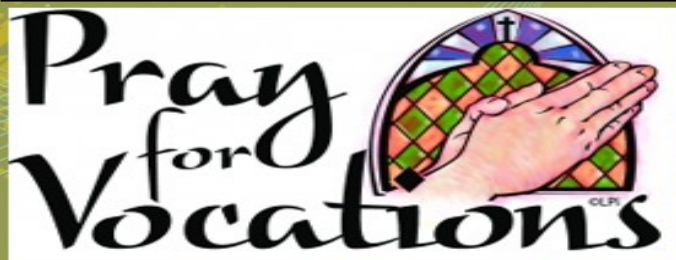


Thanks to our Garden Committee our Church is beautifully decorated for the Fall season.

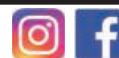

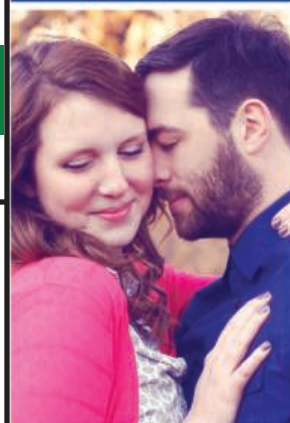
