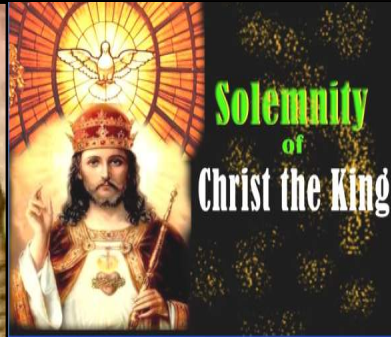

A top priority Liturgical and Devotional Project was to transform an existing Ushers Room/Storage Closet space into a serene and intentional place of prayer: an Adoration Chapel able to

accommodate up to 12 individuals. The room's focal point was shifted to the long wall, where three rows of comfortable seats, with kneelers (on most), face the floating wooden Altar shelf where the Monstrance is placed. An alarm module mounted discretely on the shelf edge provides for the dignified security of the Holy Eucharist at all times. A whisper quiet exhaust/ventilation unit was installed in the ceiling allowing for positive air flow through the space and exhausted through a concealed exterior vent, above the ceiling. The unit replaced the ceiling fan/light bar which hung from the ceiling. Both the ceiling and the walls were primed and painted in a crisp white color. New patterned carpeting (done in squares) has been laid in the chapel after consultation with our Office Staff and folks who came in the office for business. The crucifix has now been mounted on the Chapel wall with the memorialized Chapel Candle affixed to the wall behind and to the right of the Monstrance. The Chapel access door will shortly be modified to have a security window inserted. Our first ceremonial opening and use of the Adoration Chapel will be on Sunday, November 26th, beginning after the 10:00am Mass and continuing until 6:00pm when the Blessed Sacrament will return to the Monstrance over the Tabernacle at the Main Altar.

Our current plan is to provide the use of the Adoration Chapel primarily when the Sanctuary is being used for Baptisms, Wedding Rehearsals and Weddings, Funeral Visitation and Mass and other special activities, rehearsals or devotionals which require a priority access to the Sanctuary, church seating and the use of the sound system.

We will gradually phase in the fuller, full time use of the Adoration Chapel during the upcoming months as we implement enhanced safety and surveillance features to protect everyone who worships here in Church and participates in activities in all of our Parish facilities. More information will be provided at a later time.

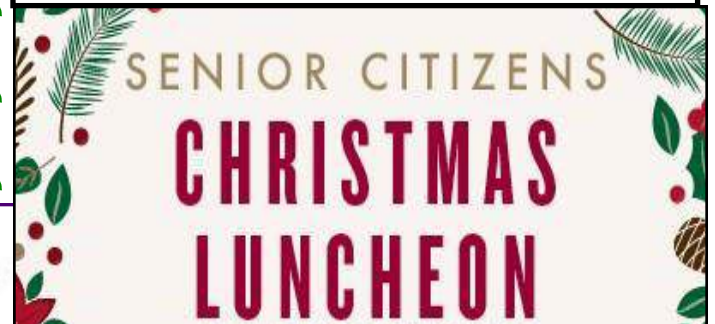

Advent: Waiting for Jesus Christ - Why do we wait?

What is the message of Advent? Why are we waiting?

Advent is a season of preparation: we shop for gifts, plan parties, and decorate our homes for the coming of Christmas. Sometimes it is easy to forget the real mission of Advent: preparing our hearts for the coming of Jesus Christ. We are bombarded by commercial messages in which the reason for Christmas—Emmanuel, “God with us”—is absent or overlooked. However, the rituals and practices of our Catholic liturgies during this season can join us together with the People of God. United, we can offer messages of challenge and hope and express our desire for God's presence in our midst.

Advent blends penitence, preparedness, and joy. We are called to consider our lives and to repent - or turn around - from those things that keep us from God. In this way, we repent and prepare for the Second Coming of the Lord. This theme of preparedness permeates the liturgies of Advent. Lastly, we are called to be joyful as we get ready to celebrate the incarnation of our Savior in Bethlehem.

We wait for the coming of Christ in human history at Bethlehem, in our hearts each day, and at the end of time. The readings of Advent direct us to be prepared as we “do not know the hour or the day” of Christ's coming. But it is the present to which we should give our attention. Christ comes to us each day in word and sacrament, in prayer and grace, and through the people in his Church. Can we try to be aware of his presence and power within our lives? Can we be open to his call and let him work through us in the world?

What is the message of Advent? For what are we waiting? *Maranatha!* Come, Lord Jesus! Help us to know you, love you, and serve you. Increase our faith. Help us understand. Let us be your eyes, ears, and hands on earth. Let us show your love. Come!

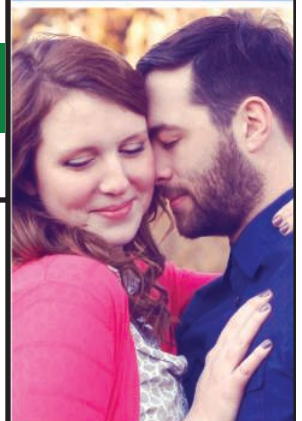
