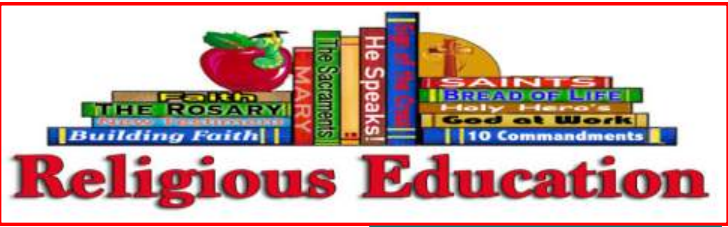

Dear Parishioners:  
 This Advent season has provided a whirlwind of activities around the parish during these past 3 weeks with: Breakfast with Santa, Santa Secret Workshop, Senior Christmas Luncheon, Choir Christmas Concert, Live Christmas Tree Sale, Parish and Religious Education Penance Services, Giving Tree gifting for families in need, special prayer events as well as our daily Masses and Novenas during the week. All of these events have a common purpose: to help direct us towards being prepared...readying our hearts and spirits to celebrate the most joyful Miracle of the Birth of Jesus Christ into our world! As you have decorated your homes and made preparations for open houses and get togethers with family and friends, our Faith community has been gathering for Mass, prayer and visits to the Blessed Sacrament in Adoration. 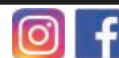

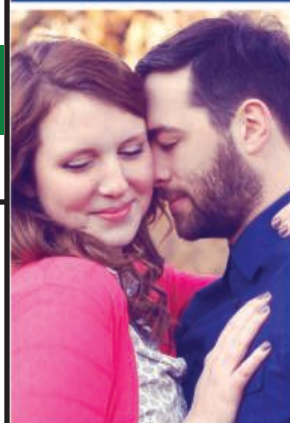
